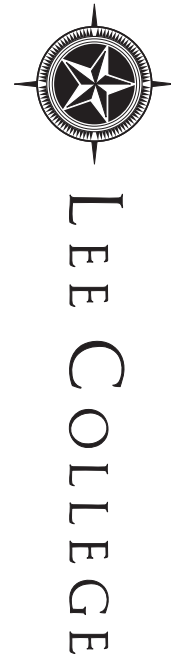

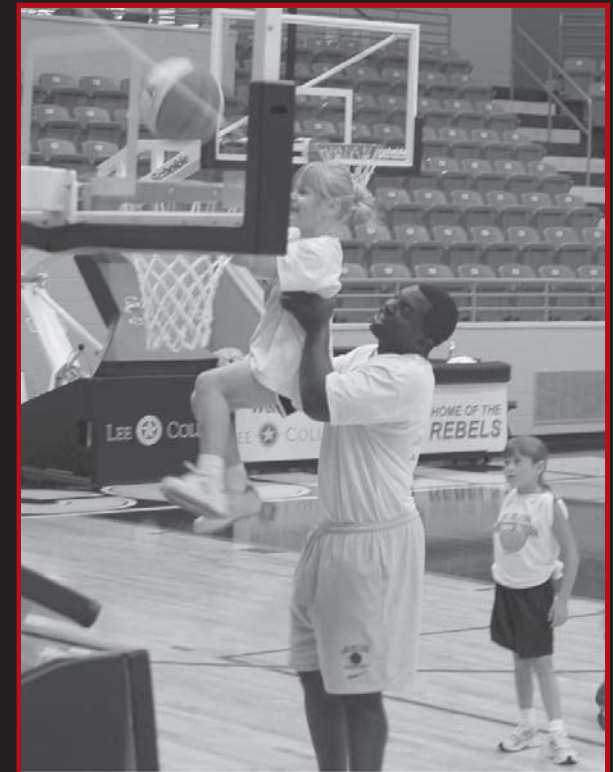

Camp Objectives



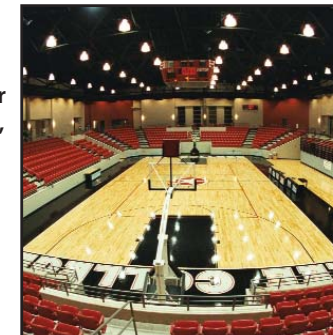
- Each camper will leave with a positive attitude.
