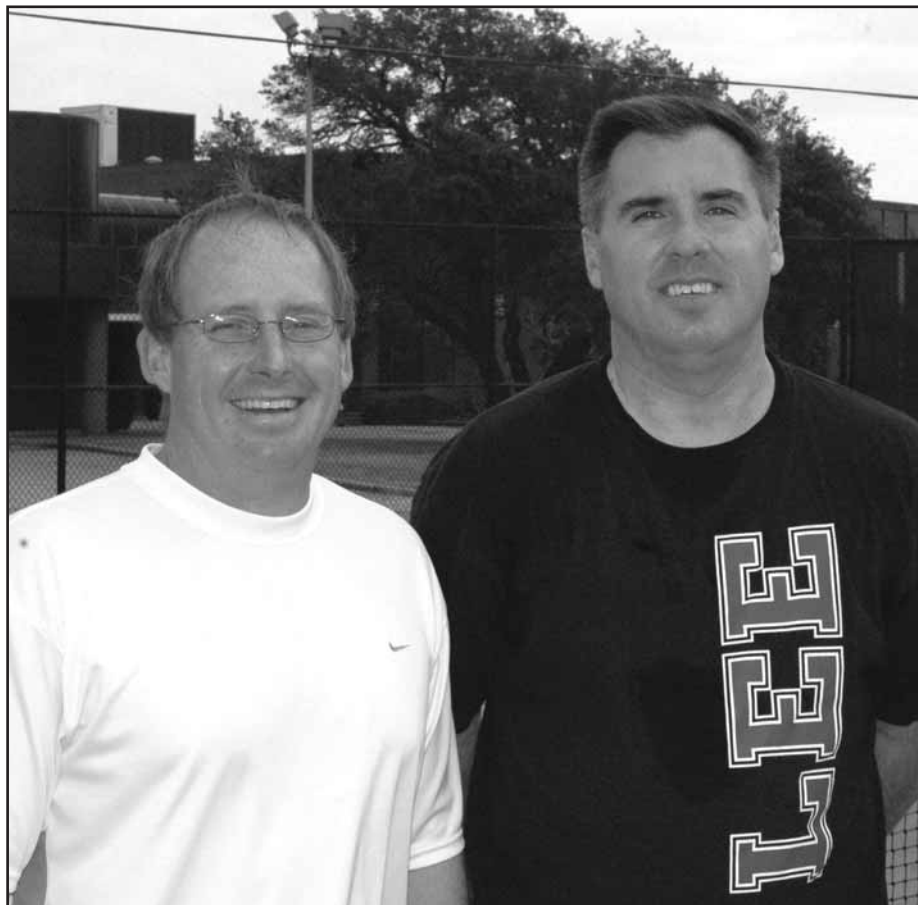

9th season at Lee College



Jason Haynes is entering his ninth season as head coach for the Lee College tennis team. Under the guidance of Coach Haynes, the Lady Rebels tennis team has soared to amazing heights culminating in the NJCAA National Championships in 2001 and 2007. Coach Haynes has also led the Lady Rebels to 2nd place national rankings in 2000, 2002, 2003 & 2004.

The 2005 season produced Lee College's first National Champion in the singles competition. Ms. Loli Aguire-Gomez won the event.

Since his arrival at Lee College, Haynes has established the Lee College tennis team as one of the top and most successful programs in the nation. Haynes was recognized for his accomplishments by being named Wilson/TTCA College Tennis Coach of the Year in 2002, and ITA/Wilson Junior College Coach of the Year in 2003.

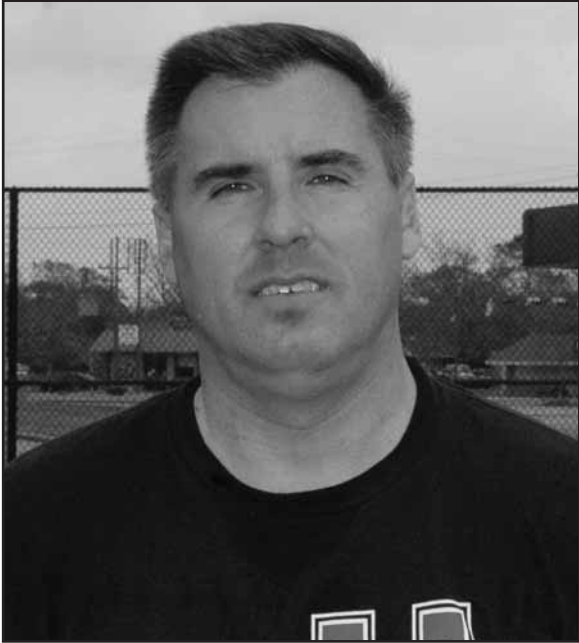
Under Coach Haynes, the tennis program has won one National Championship; four 2nd place finishes nationally and has produced 18 All-Americans, three Academic All-Americans, and four Distinguished All-Americans.

Before arriving at Lee College, Haynes had several successful coaching stints with different institutions such as: Tyler Junior College, Southwest Texas State University, and Bullard High School.

While serving as women's assistant coach at Tyler Junior College, Haynes helped Tyler win back-to-back National Championships and a second place finish in the National Tournament. During his three year tenure at Tyler the tennis program produced 12 NJCAA All-Americans.

As men's assistant coach at SWT, Haynes earned valuable experience under head tennis coach Neal Kinlund while at the same time serving as assistant coach at Bullard High School, who under the guidance of Haynes became state qualifiers in back-to-back seasons.
