Future Arts Center

The fabulous new Performing Arts Center at Lee College is scheduled to break ground this summer and be ready to occupy in August 2008. It will have over 35,000 square feet of space with a theater seating nearly 700, a smaller "black box" theater, a fully equipped recording studio, and two recital halls—one for voice and one for instruments.

In addition to these major spaces, it will have classrooms, labs, rehearsal rooms, and all the other facilities that students will need. The Performing Arts Center plans also include an orchestra pit, a full fly loft, state of the art acoustics for drama and orchestra, and full recording ability in each of the performance spaces.

This facility will put Baytown on the Harris County map for first-class facilities matching those in downtown Houston. For those of you that remember the performing arts at Lee College in earlier, more limited days, celebrate this new future with us.
