### 1. Registration Number

### 2. Course Prefix

A 4-character subject abbreviation.

### 3. Course Number

A 3- or 4-digit number. In a 4-digit number, the second number identifies the number of credits that will be earned. A 3-digit number indicates a developmental level course. See the current Lee College catalog for additional information.
