The Lee College website provides students with a number of valuable online resources right at their desktop.

iCAMPUS

Returning students and new students who have been admitted to the college can access iCampus at www.lee.edu with a student user ID and password. The user ID is the same as for myLC, see below. iCampus provides a number of online services for students such as online registration, retrieving course grades and obtaining unofficial transcripts.

myLC and WebCT

Returning students and new students who have been admitted to the college can access free email by clicking the WebCT logo at www.lee.edu. This email address is used to send students important information from the college. There will be a 24 - 36 hour initial wait time for new myLC accounts. For distance education students using WebCT, access can also be found by clicking the WebCT logo at www.lee.edu. Both sites have links for log-in information.

CAMPUS CONNECTIONS

Students can participate in an online discussion board to get answers or to post questions on topics such as student issues, campus events or create study groups or find a tutor. Students can access "Campus Connections" at www.lee.edu. Campus Connections is sponsored and monitored by the IT Department at Lee College.

SMARTHINKING

– Free Online Tutoring Services

Lee College students can connect with an e-structor and receive online personalized tutoring assistance in Math, Writing, Business and Science. Simply submit your question or writing sample and a tutor will reply usually within 24 hours. Students can access SMARTHINKING at www.lee.edu and create a personal account to begin using the tutoring services.

WIFI Access

Lee College provides WIFI wireless network support for students with laptops. WIFI access areas include the Student Center building, Moler Hall, Moler Hall Patio and the gazebo area near Bonner Hall. Students must obtain a login name and password from the Office of Information Technology at Lee College. Students interested in a WIFI connection are encouraged to visit www.lee.edu for additional information about the college's usage policy.

REBEL JOB LINK

Rebel Job Link (www.lee.edu/hirearebel) is a state-of-the-art career management tool for Lee College students and graduates. It allows you to access online job postings for internships and part-time and full-time job opportunities, set up job agents to alert you about specific job openings, receive email updates on new job leads, as well as view a calendar of upcoming career-related events (i.e. workshops, guest speakers, job fairs, on-campus interviews, and much more).
