# Lee College Graduate Report 2001-2002 Graduates

July 2003

---

The data in this report pertain to students who earned certificates or degrees during the academic year 2001-2002. The data which underlie this report are taken from the official Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board reports. The data pertaining to enrollment headcounts and educational objectives are derived from the CBM001, and the data pertaining to certificates and degrees awarded are from the CBM009.

The analysis presented in the report includes comparisons of the number of certificates and degrees awarded during the 2001-2002 academic year with the number of students enrolled Fall 2001 and the number of students seeking certificates and degrees during Fall 2001.

Data are presented for Lee College totals, Baytown campus totals, and HC/LC only.

## **Highlights of the report:**

- ⇒ 0.43% more degrees and certificates were awarded to Lee College students than the previous academic year (compared to enrollment).
- ⇒ For the Baytown campus, the ratio of awards to enrollment was down 0.1%, continuing a five-year trend.
- ⇒ 6.94% more degrees and certificates were awarded to HC/LC students than in the previous year.
- ⇒ The percentage of Lee College students seeking certificates was 37.4, while 11.8% earned a certificate.
- ⇒ 57.1% of Lee College students declared that they were seeking a degree, and 6.6% earned one.
- ⇒ The top three areas for degree/certificate awards at the Baytown campus were Administrative Assistant, Chemical Technology, and General Nursing.

- ⇒ Data Processing Technology, Electronics Technology, and Horticulture were the top three award areas at HC/LC.
- ⇒ 1148 degrees and certificates were awarded to 1023 students.
- ⇒ Within the Gulf Coast Consortium, Lee College, including HC/LC, is ranked #1 in the percentage of certificates awarded. Excluding HC/LC, Lee College is #3.
- ⇒ Lee College ranks #3 statewide among community colleges in the percentage of incarcerated students receiving degrees, and #4 in the percentage of incarcerated students receiving certificates. Lee College ranks #1 among state community colleges in incarcerated credit student headcount.

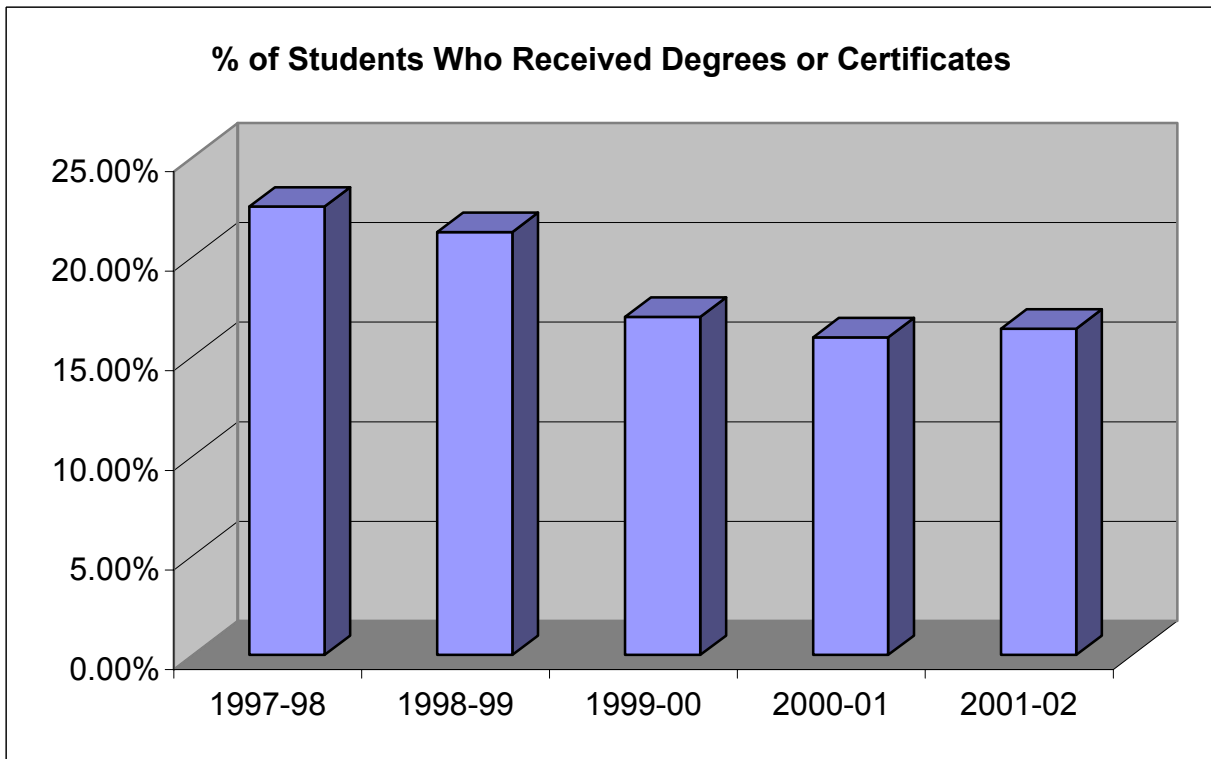

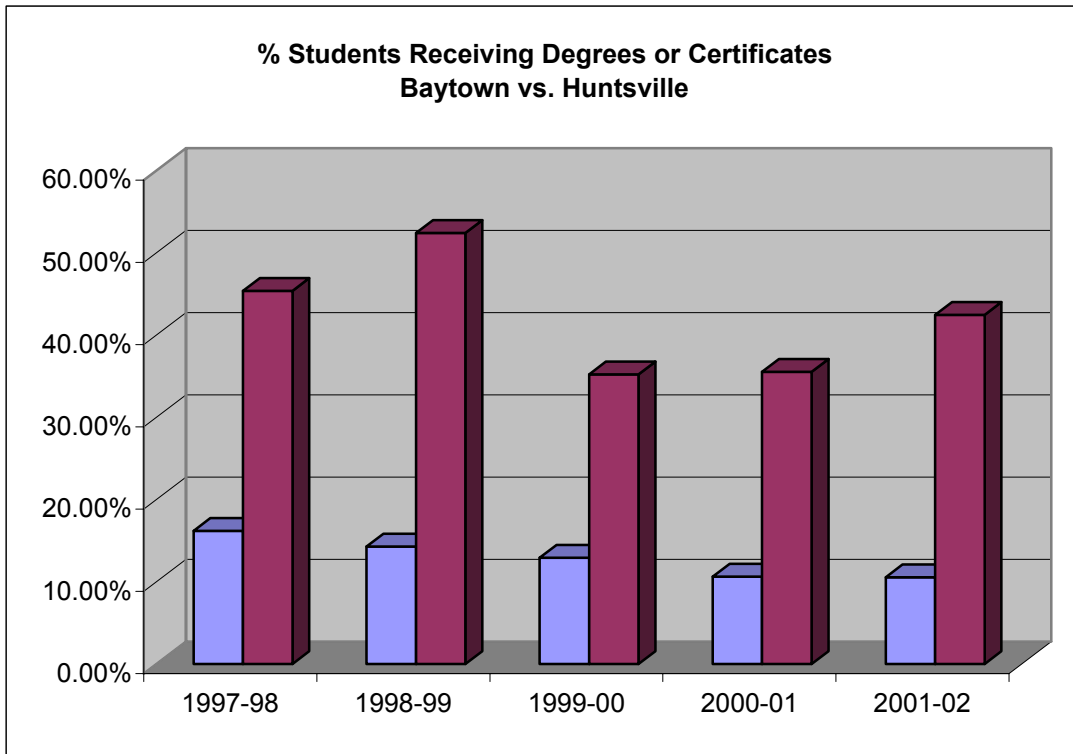

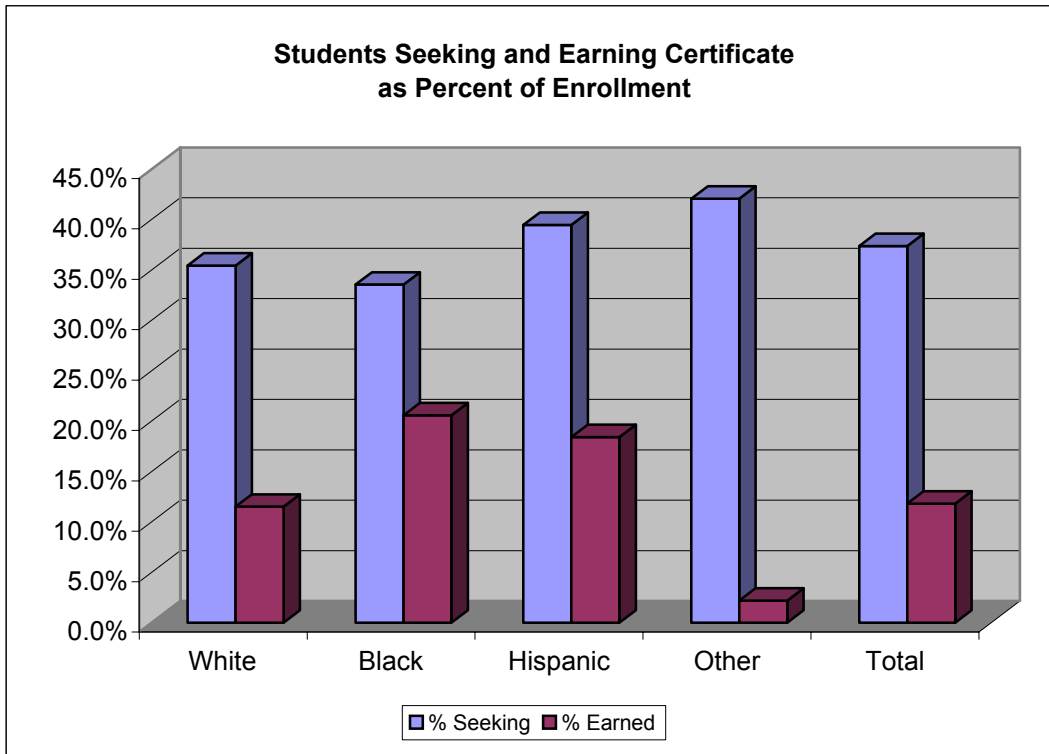

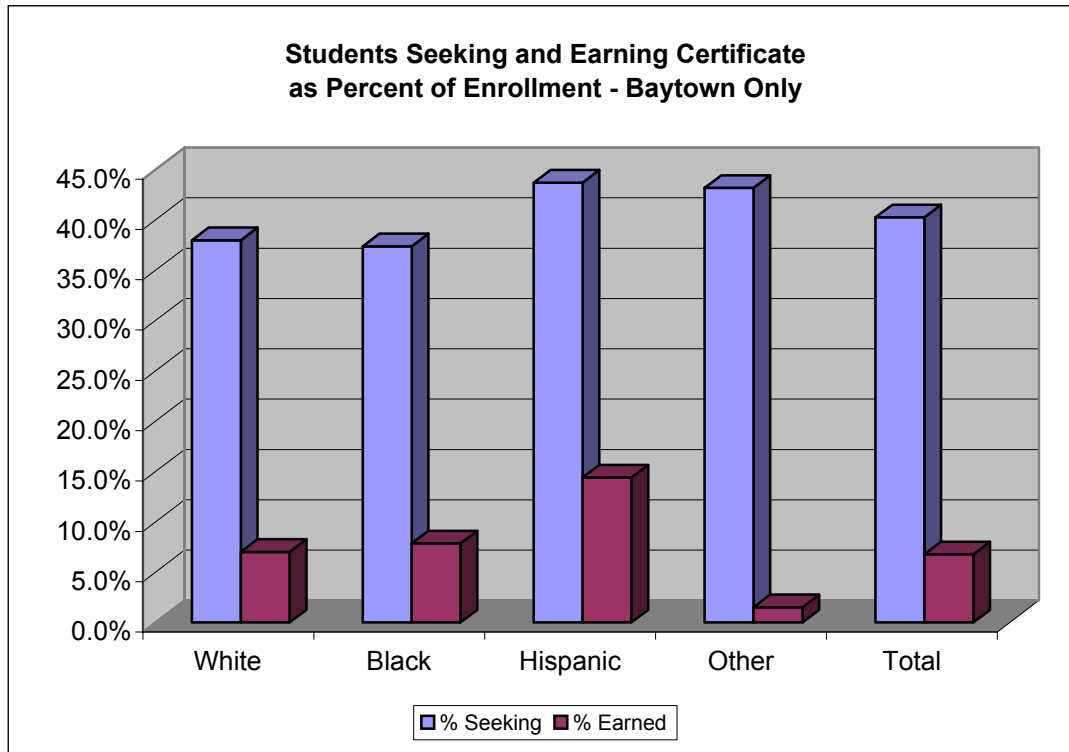

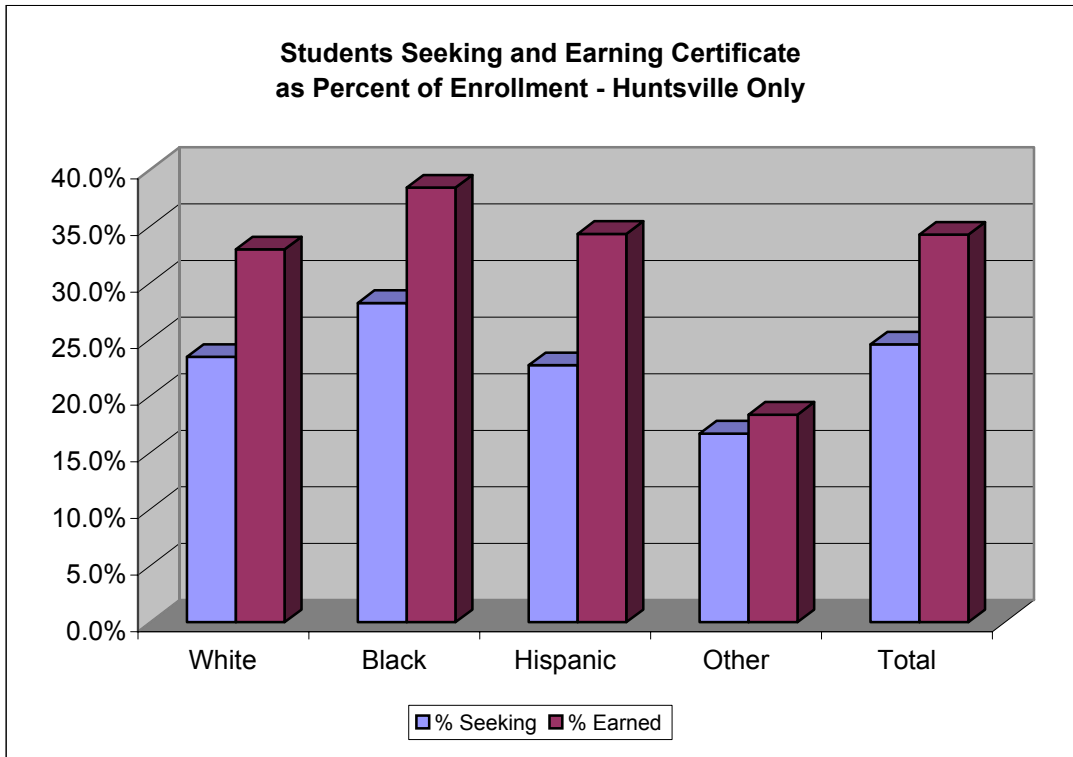

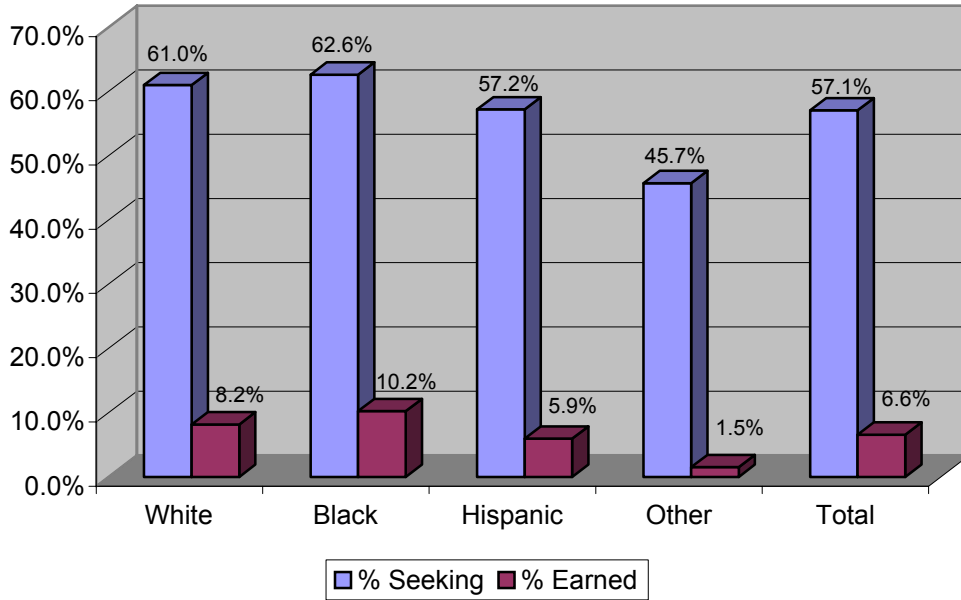

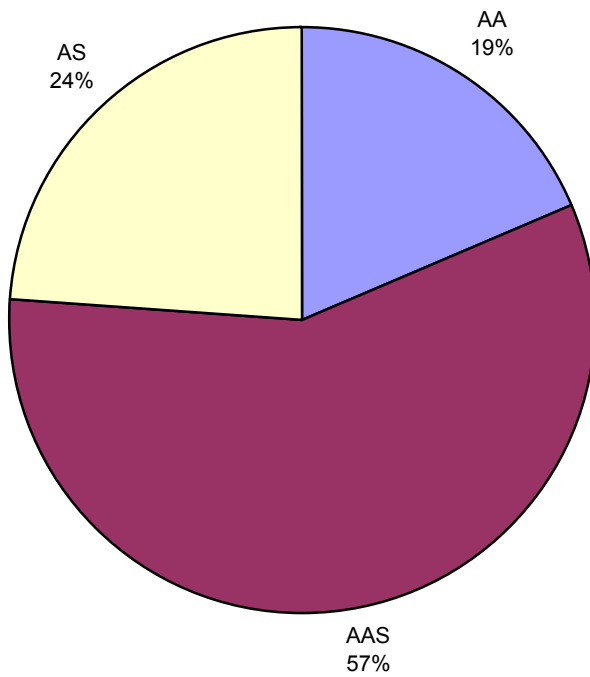

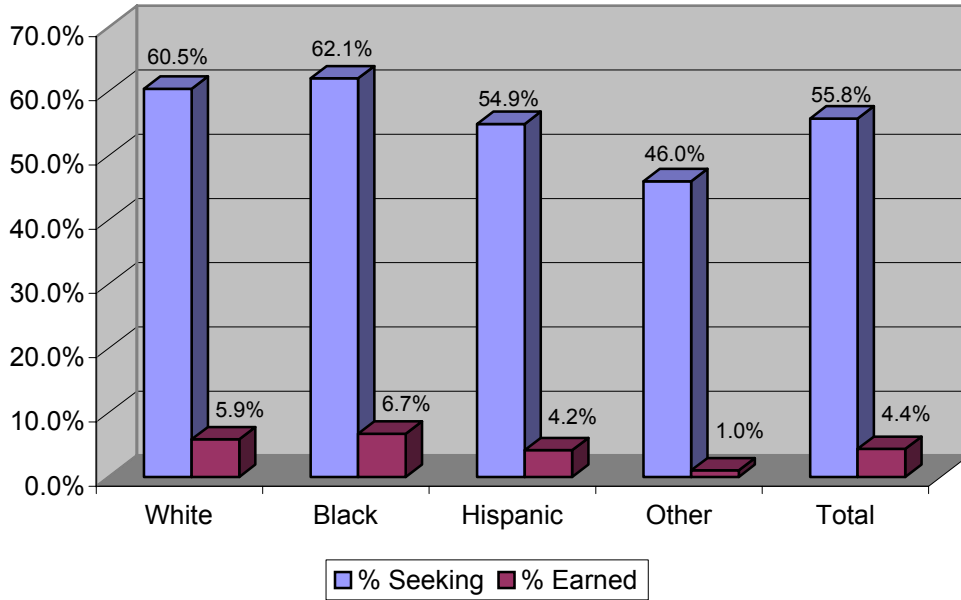

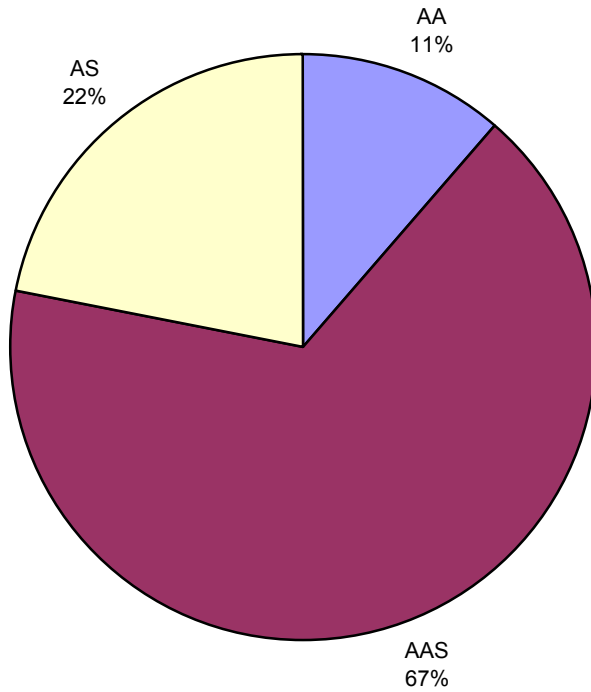

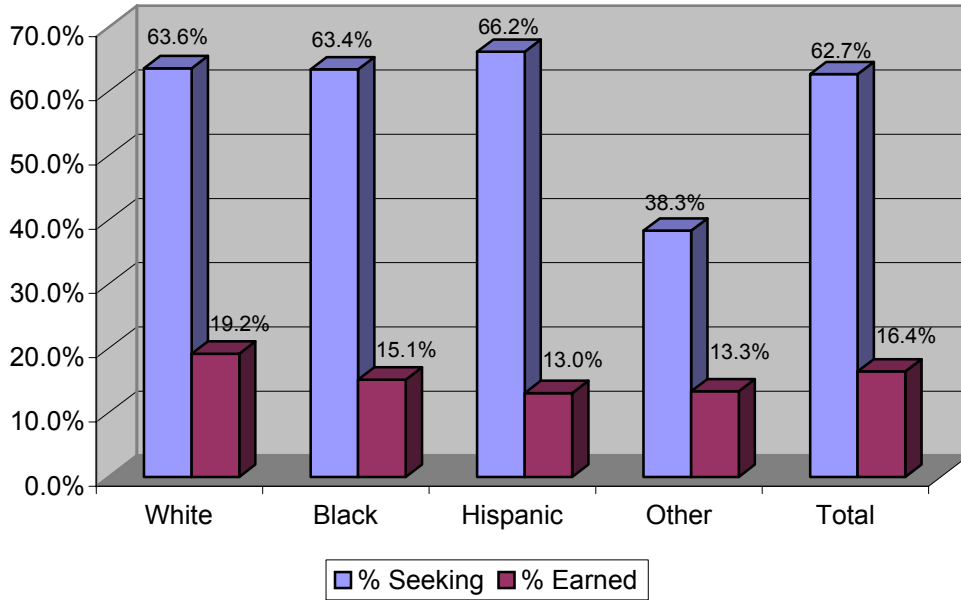

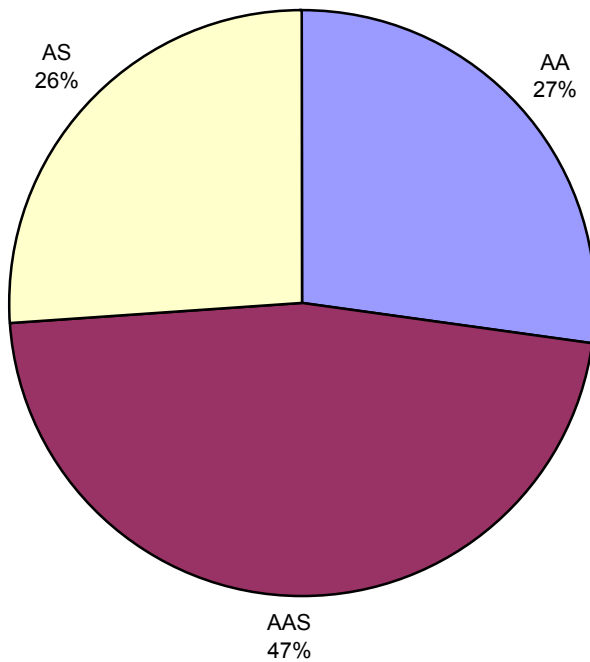
