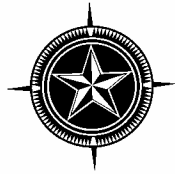

Lee College Graduate Report 2002-2003 Graduates

July 2004

The data in this report pertain to students who earned certificates or degrees during the academic year 2002-2003. The data which underlie this report are taken from the official Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board reports. The data pertaining to enrollment headcounts and educational objectives are derived from the CBM001, and the data pertaining to certificates and degrees awarded are from the CBM009.

The analysis presented in the report includes comparisons of the number of certificates and degrees awarded during the 2002-2003 academic year with the number of students enrolled Fall 2002 and the number of students seeking certificates and degrees during Fall 2002.

Data are presented for Lee College totals, Baytown campus totals, and HC/LC only.

Highlights of the report:

- ⇒ 0.7% more degrees and certificates were awarded to Lee College students than the previous academic year (compared to enrollment).
- ⇒ For the Baytown campus, the ratio of awards to enrollment was down 0.12%, continuing a five-year trend.
- ⇒ 4.55% more degrees and certificates were awarded to HC/LC students than in the previous year.
- ⇒ The percentage of Lee College students seeking certificates was 37.6, while 12.1% earned a certificate.
- ⇒ 45.2% of Lee College students declared that they were seeking a degree, and 7.5% earned one.
- ⇒ The top three areas for degree/certificate awards at the Baytown campus were Administrative Assistant, Chemical Technology, and Business Administration and Management.

- ⇒ Commercial Vehicle Operation, Horticulture, and Telecommunications Technology were the top three award areas at HC/LC.
- ⇒ 1258 degrees and certificates were awarded to 1093 students.
- ⇒ Within the Gulf Coast Consortium, Lee College is ranked #1 in the percentage of certificates awarded.
- ⇒ Within the Gulf Coast Consortium, Lee College is ranked #2 in the percentage of degrees awarded.

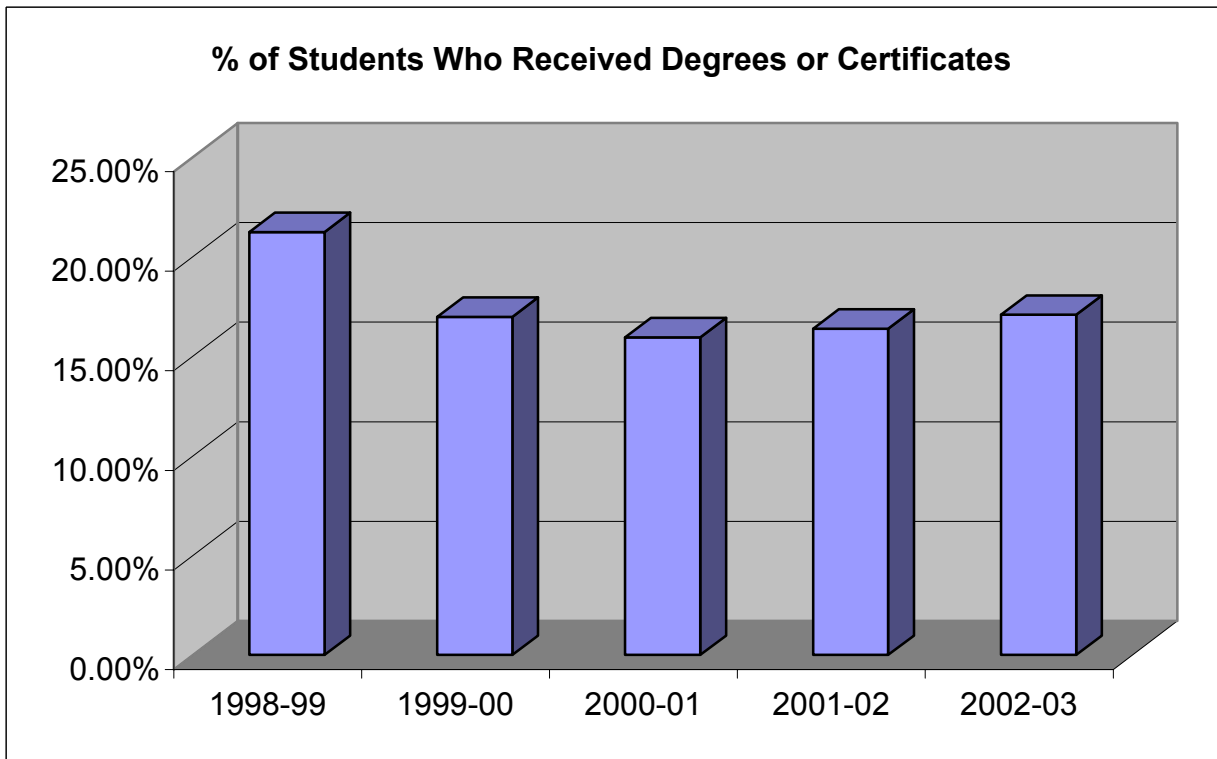

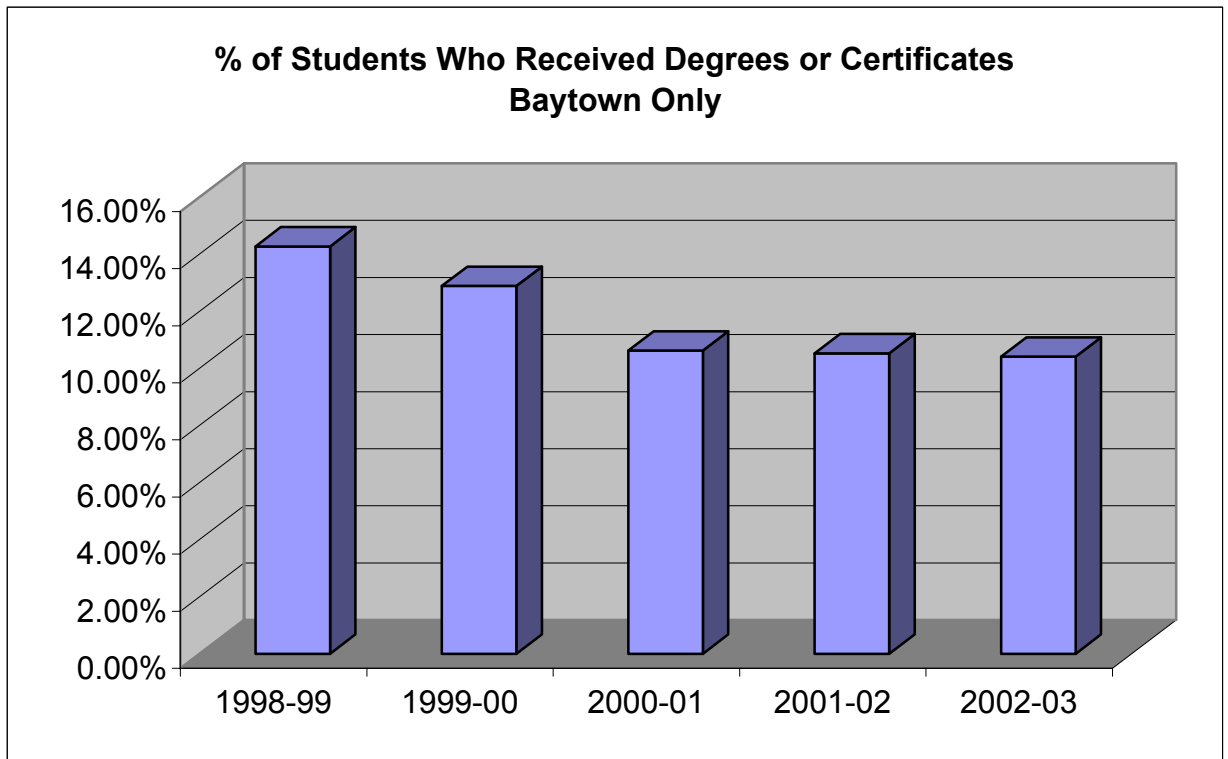

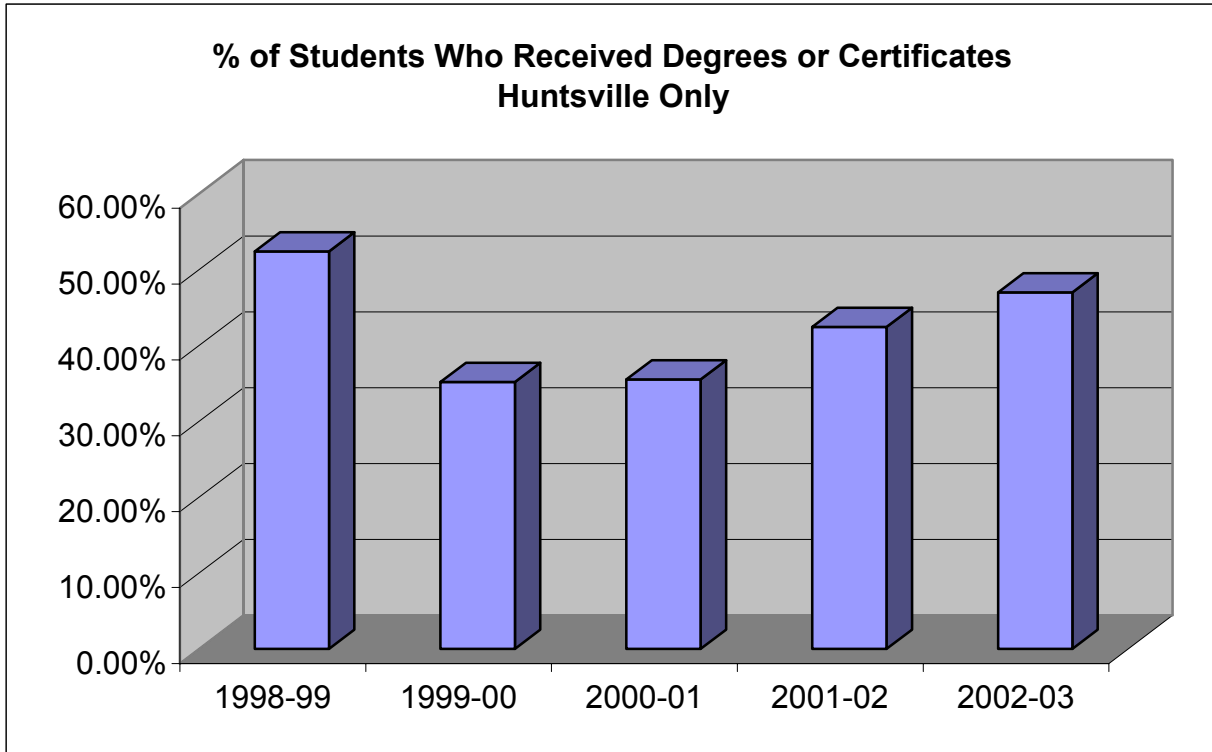

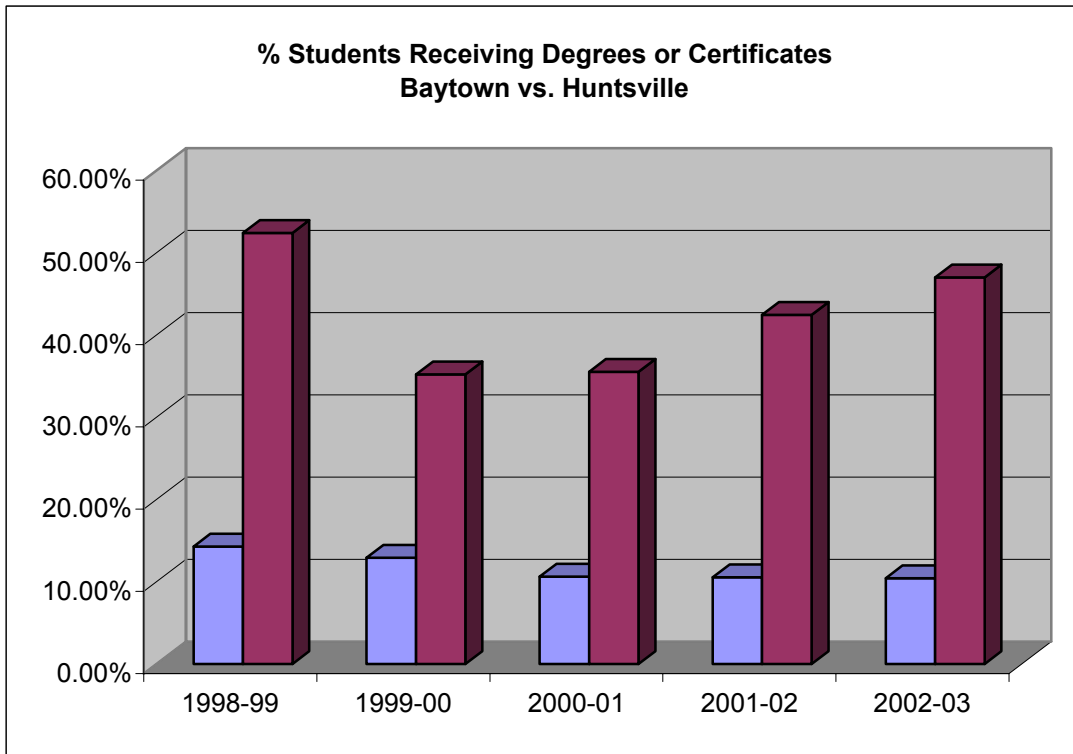

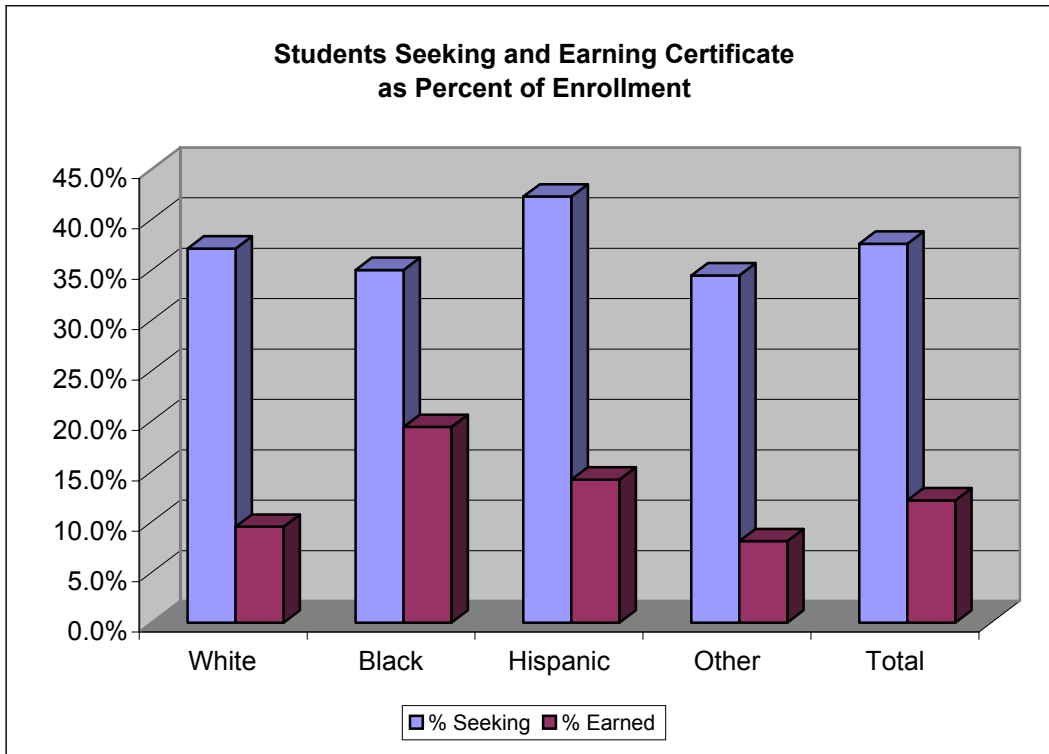

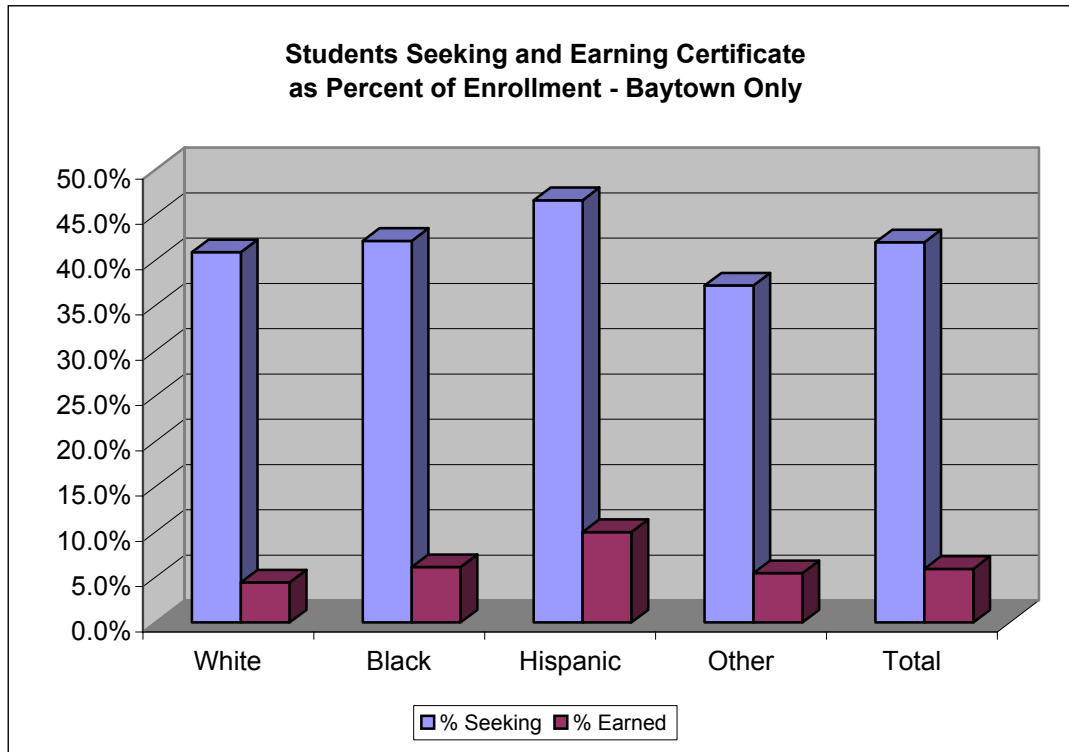

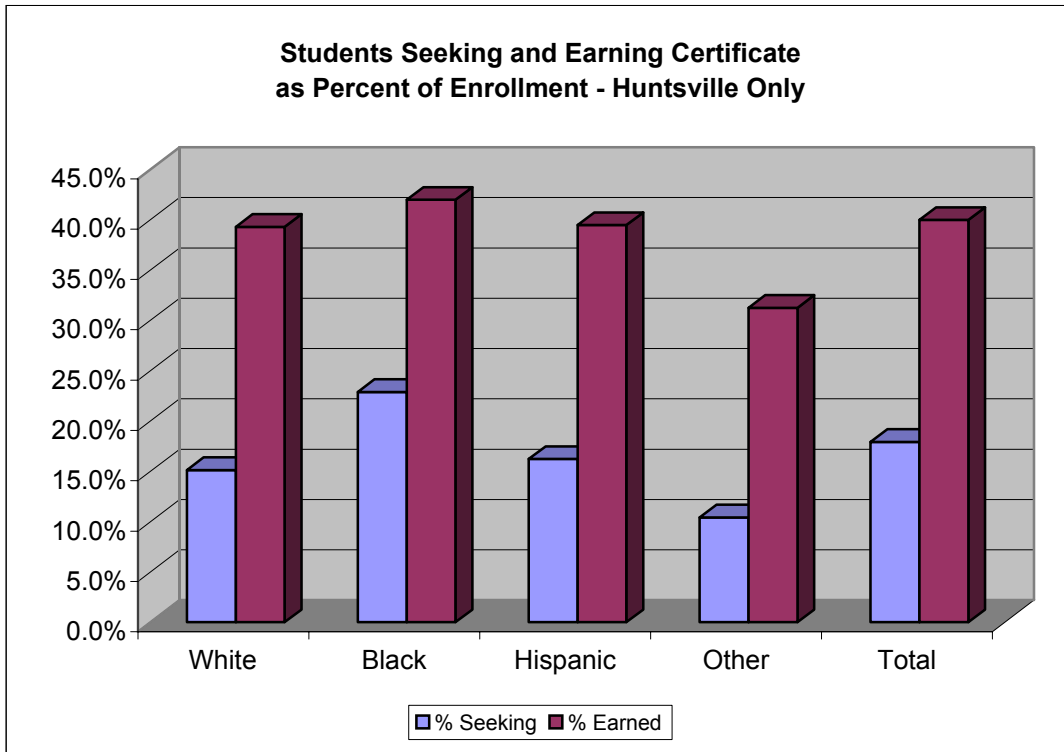

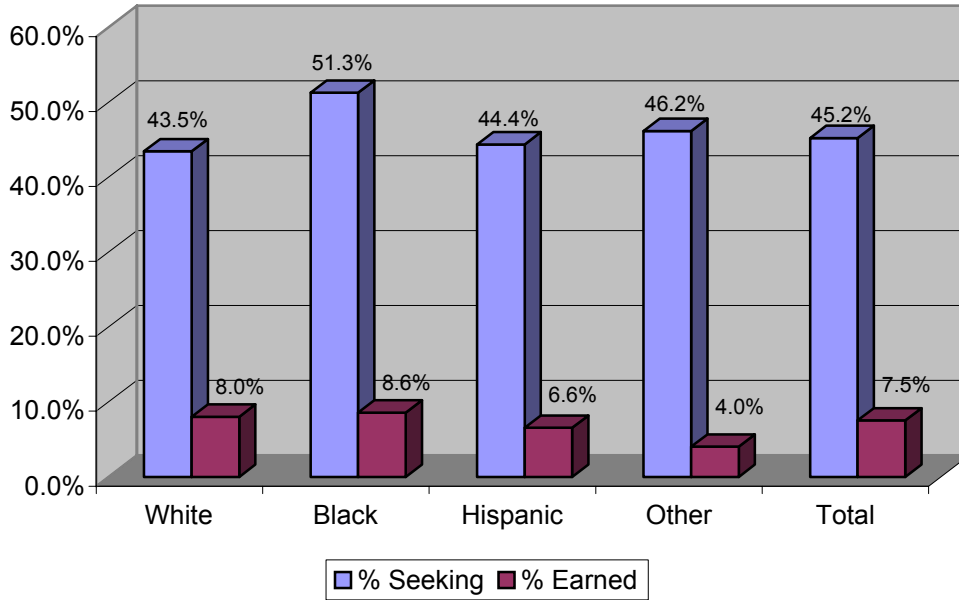

Types of Degrees Earned

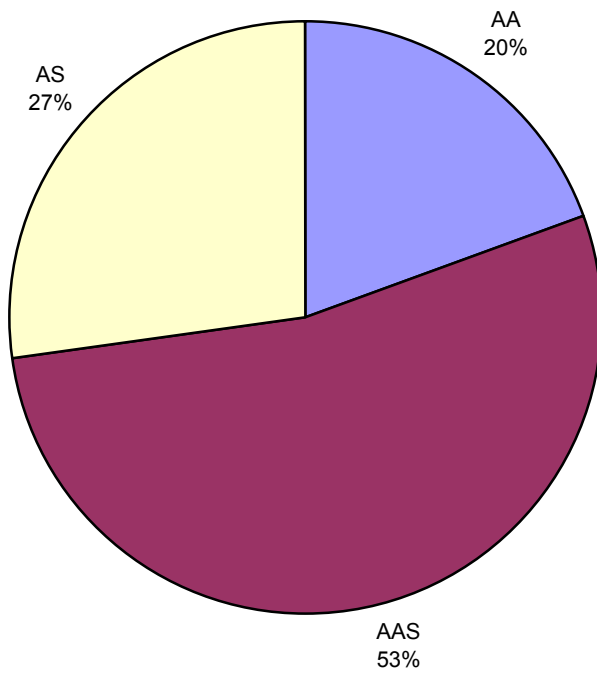

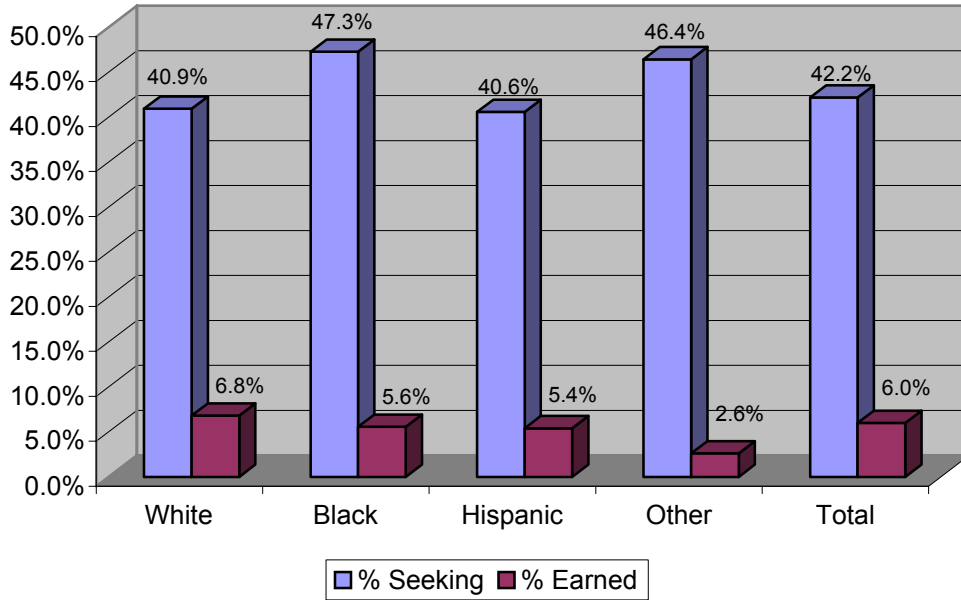

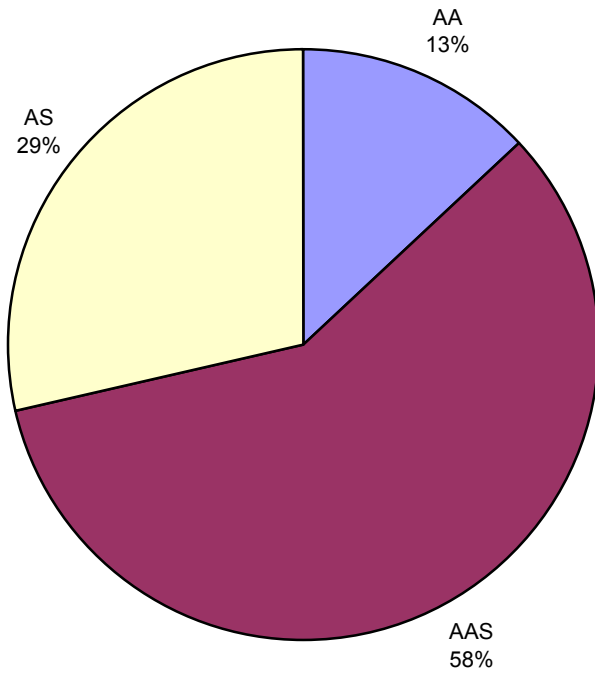

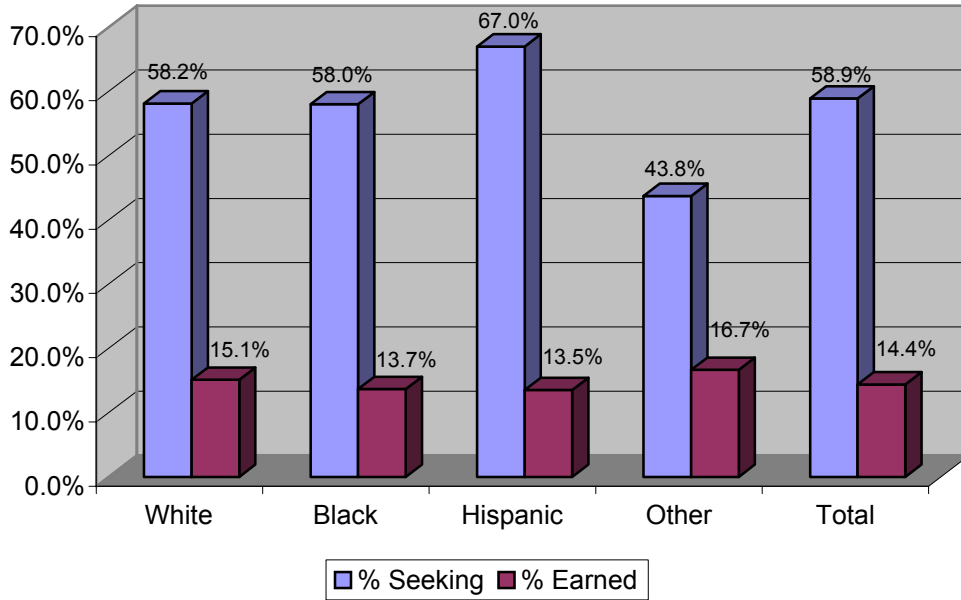

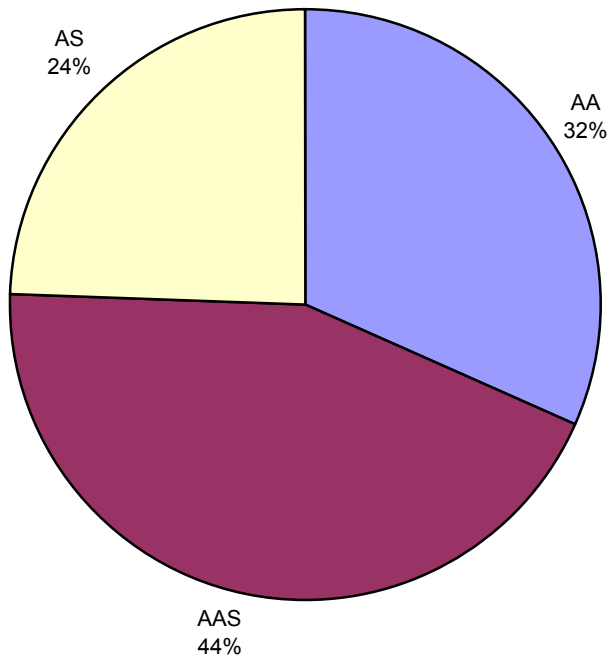
