Lee College Graduate Report 2003-2004 Graduates

July 2005

The data in this report pertain to students who earned certificates or degrees during the academic year 2003-2004. The data which underlie this report are taken from the official Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board reports. The data pertaining to enrollment headcounts and educational objectives are derived from the CBM001, and the data pertaining to certificates and degrees awarded are from the CBM009.

The analysis presented in the report includes comparisons of the number of certificates and degrees awarded during the 2003-2004 academic year with the number of students enrolled Fall 2003 and the number of students seeking certificates and degrees during Fall 2003.

Data are presented for Lee College totals, Baytown campus totals, and HC/LC only.

Highlights of the report:

- ⇒ 0.6% more degrees and certificates were awarded to Lee College students than the previous academic year (compared to enrollment).
- ⇒ For the Baytown campus, the ratio of awards to enrollment was up 0.98% from the previous year, reversing a five-year trend.
- ⇒ The ratio of awards to enrollment increased 3.59% over the previous year for HC/LC students.
- ⇒ The percentage of Lee College students seeking certificates was 36.9, while 12.0% earned a certificate.
- ⇒ 45.7% of Lee College students declared that they were seeking a degree, and 8.0% earned one.
- ⇒ The top three areas for degree/certificate awards at the Baytown campus were Chemical Technology, Administrative Assistant, and Instrumentation Technology.

- ⇒ Horticulture, Telecommunications Technology, and Commercial Vehicle Operation were the top three award areas at HC/LC.
- ⇒ 1,268 degrees and certificates were awarded to 1,121 students.

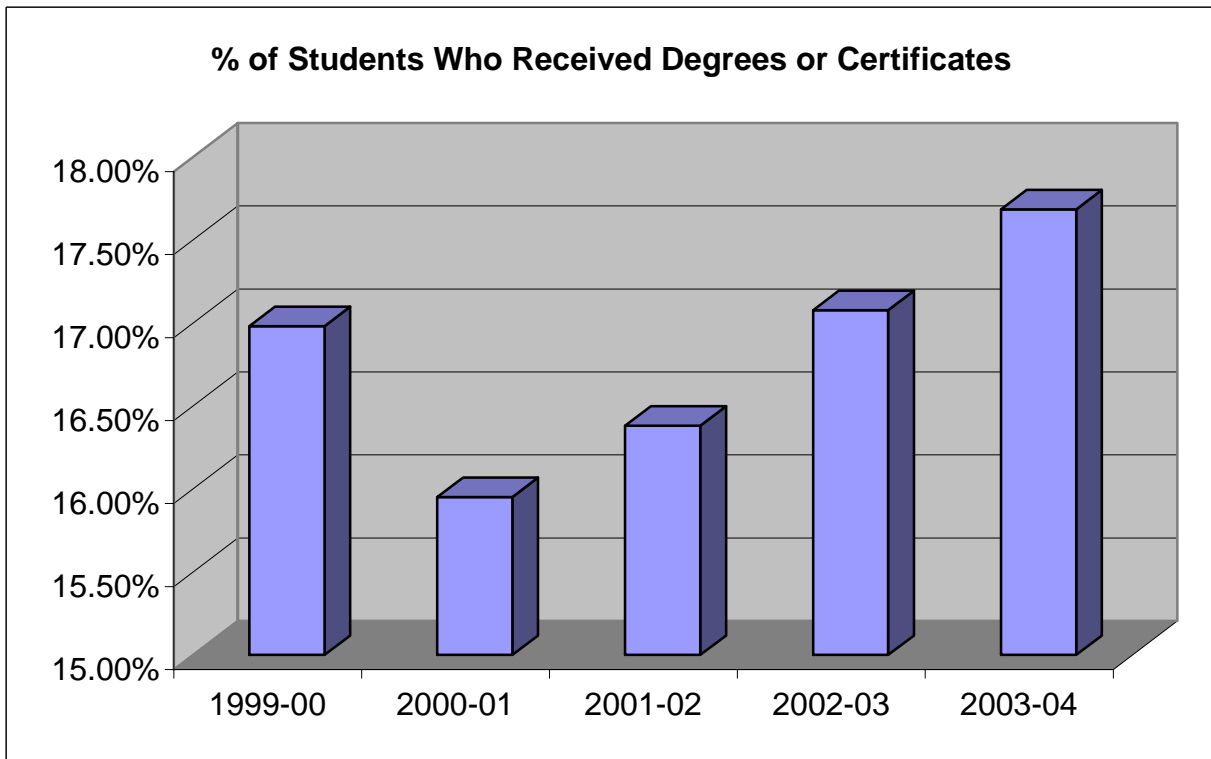

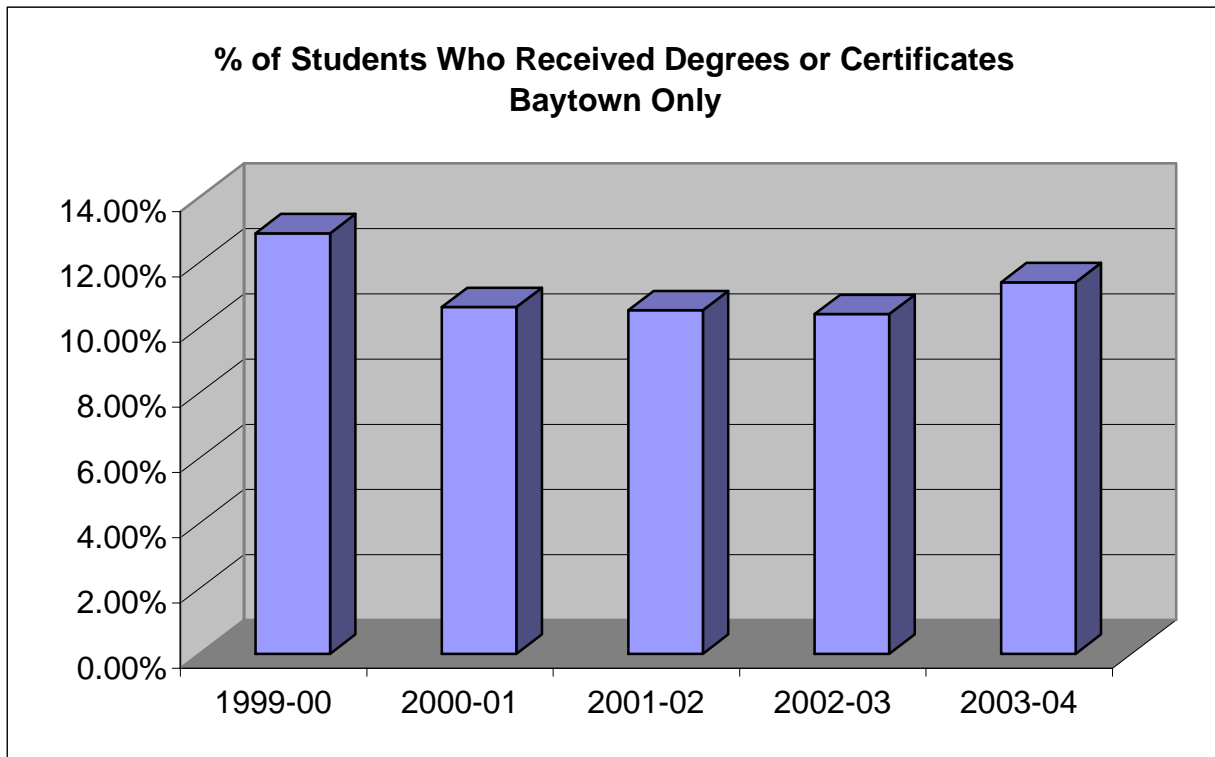

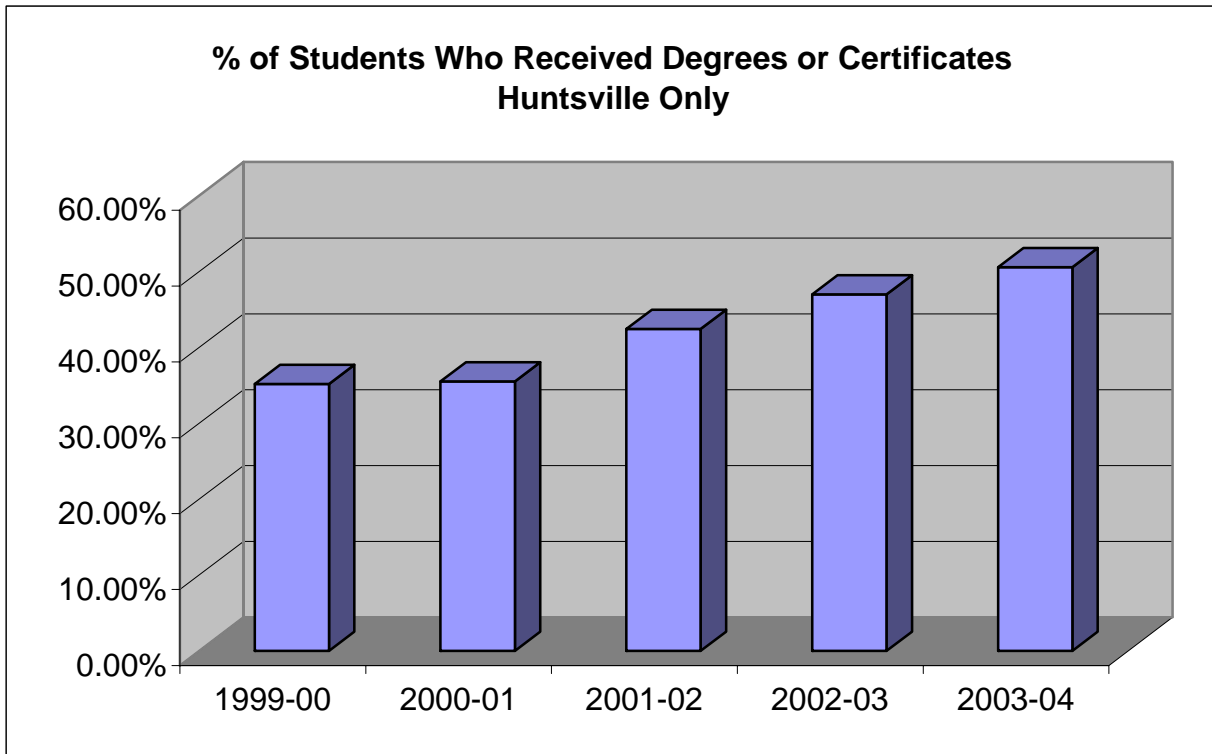

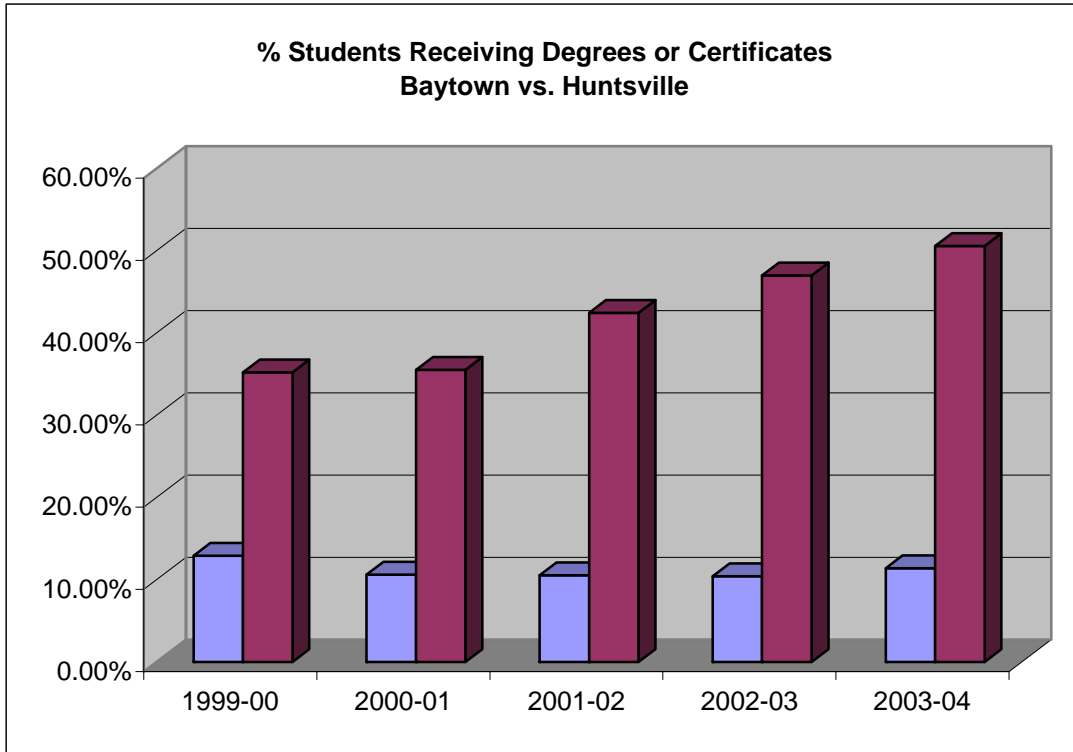

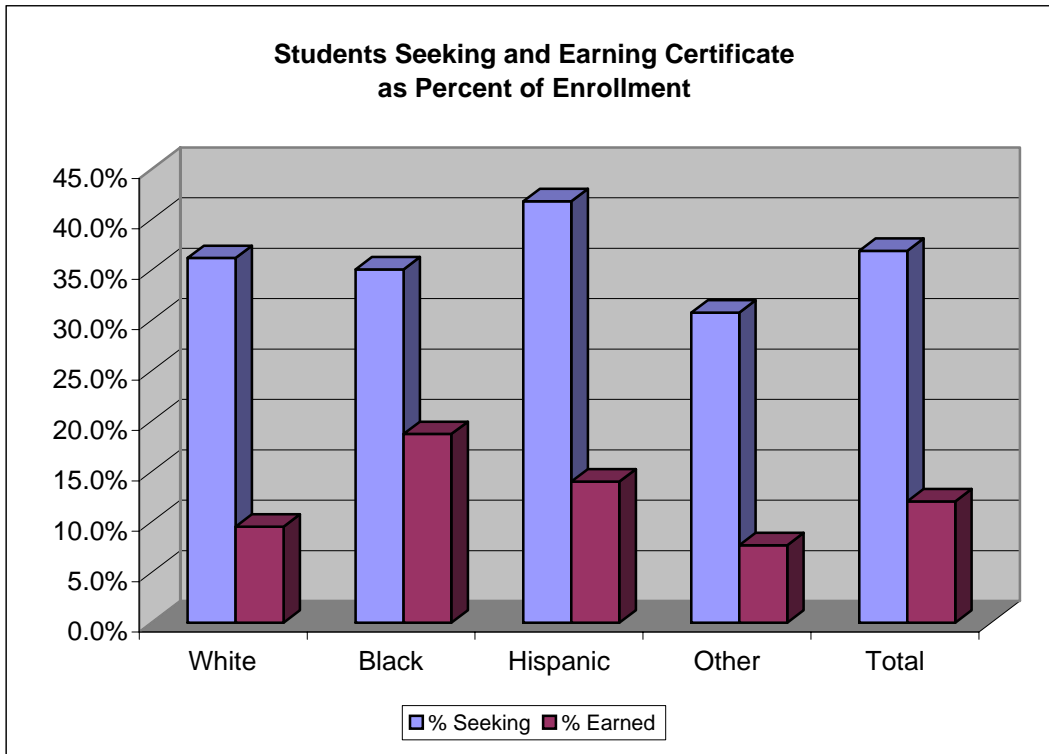

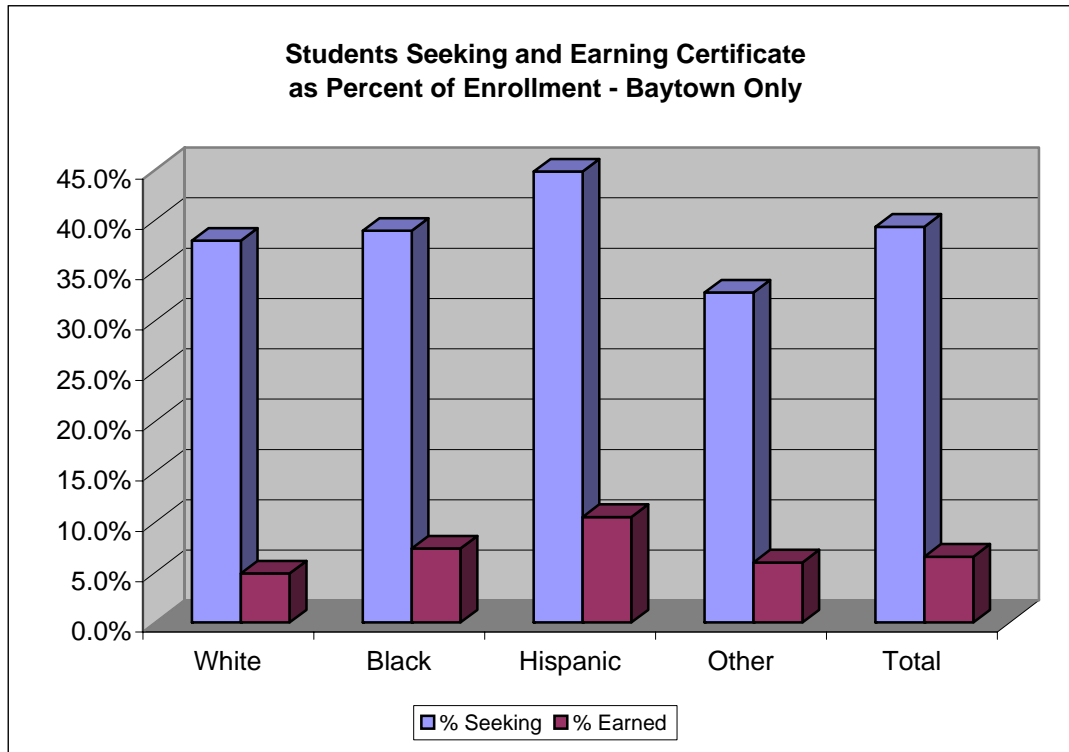

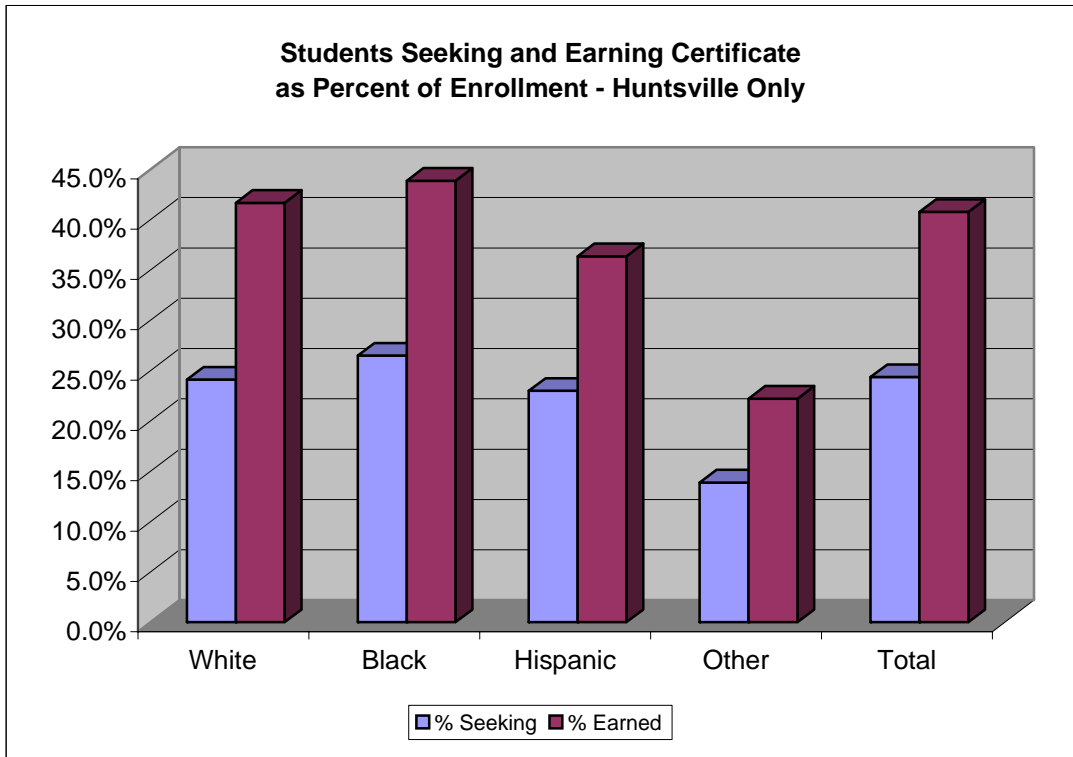

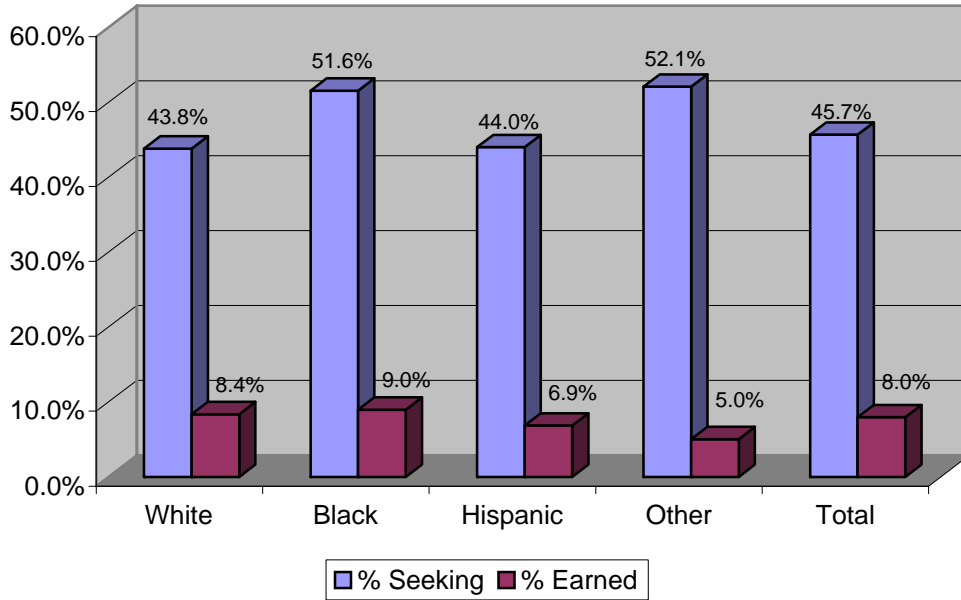

Types of Degrees Earned

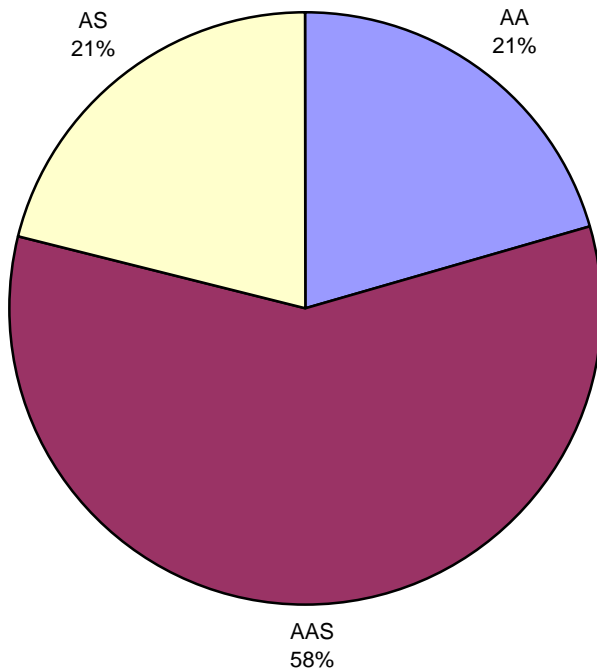

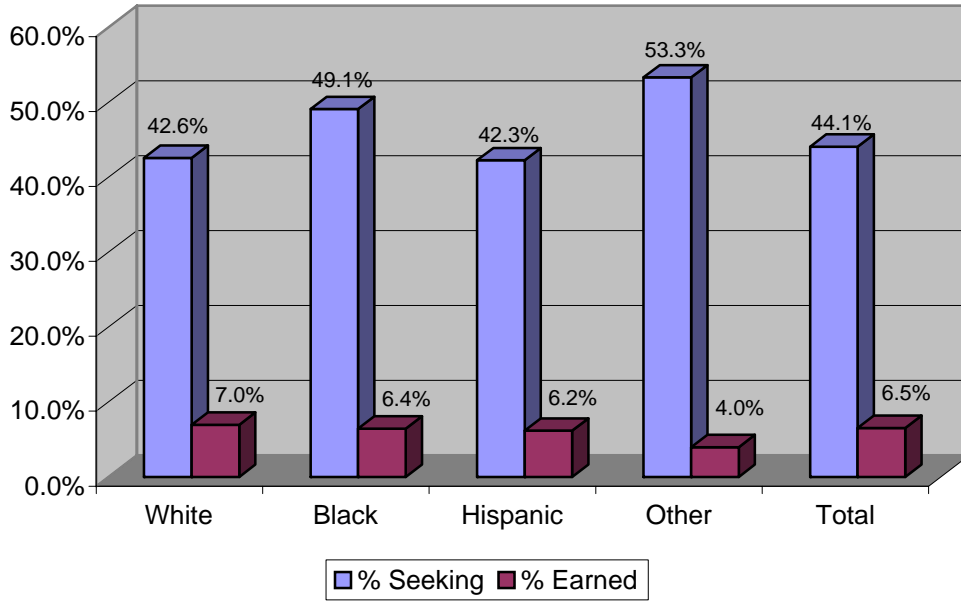

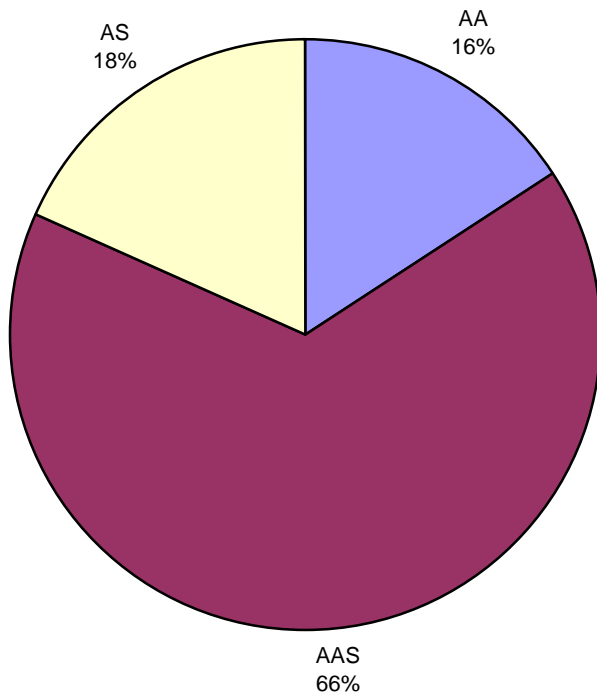

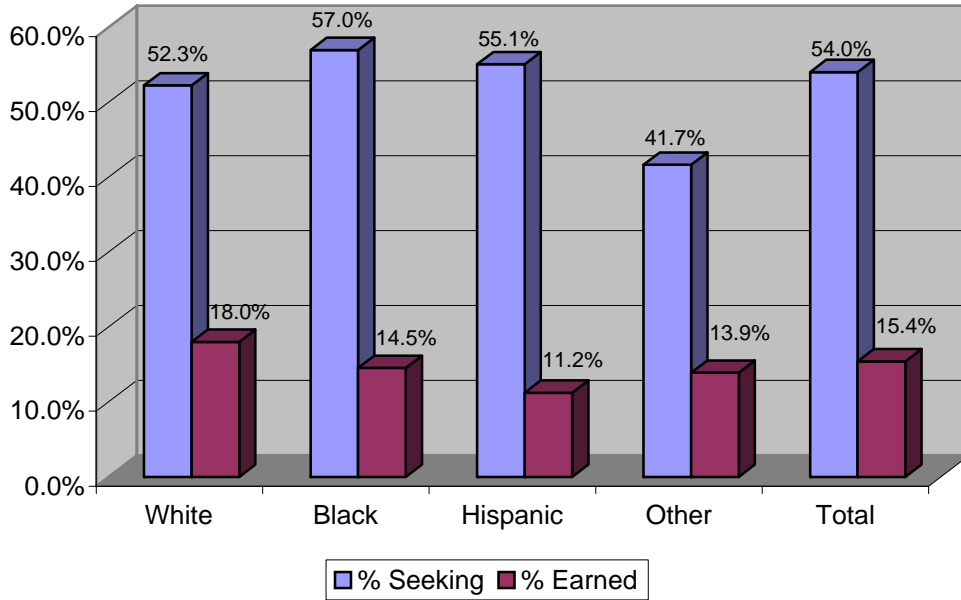

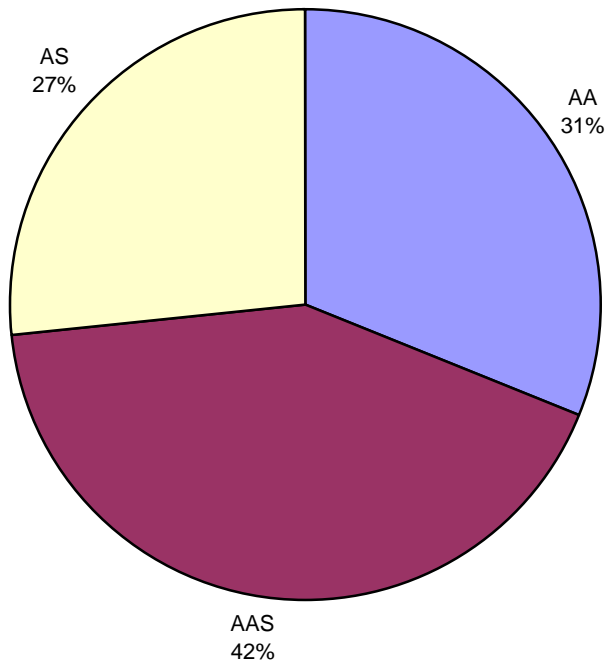
