Lee College Graduate Report 2007-2008 Graduates

December 2008

The data in this report pertain to students who earned certificates or degrees during the academic year 2007-2008. The data which underlie this report are taken from the official Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board reports. The data pertaining to enrollment headcounts and educational objectives are derived from the CBM001, and the data pertaining to certificates and degrees awarded are from the CBM009.

The analysis presented in the report includes comparisons of the number of certificates and degrees awarded during the 2007-2008 academic year with the number of students enrolled Fall 2007 and the number of students seeking certificates and degrees during Fall 2007.

Data are presented for Lee College totals, Baytown campus totals, and Huntsville campus totals only.

Highlights of the report:

- ✚ 0.01% more degrees and certificates were awarded to Lee College students than the previous academic year (compared to enrollment)
- ✚ For the Baytown campus, the ratio of awards to enrollment was up 1.15% from the previous year.
- ✚ The ratio of awards to enrollment decreased 22.11% from the previous year for the Huntsville campus students.
- ✚ The percentage of Lee College students seeking certificates was 31.8%, while 13.7% earned a certificate.
- ✚ 59.4% of Lee College students declared that they were seeking a degree, and 10.2% earned one.
- ✚ The top three areas for degree/certificate awards at the Baytown campus were Chemical Technology/Technician, Drafting & Design Technology, and Administrative Assistant and Secretarial Science.
- ✚ Agricultural Business Technology, Truck and Bus Driver, and Business Administration & Management were the top three award areas at the Huntsville campus.
- ✚ 1,390 degrees and certificates were awarded to 1,214 students.

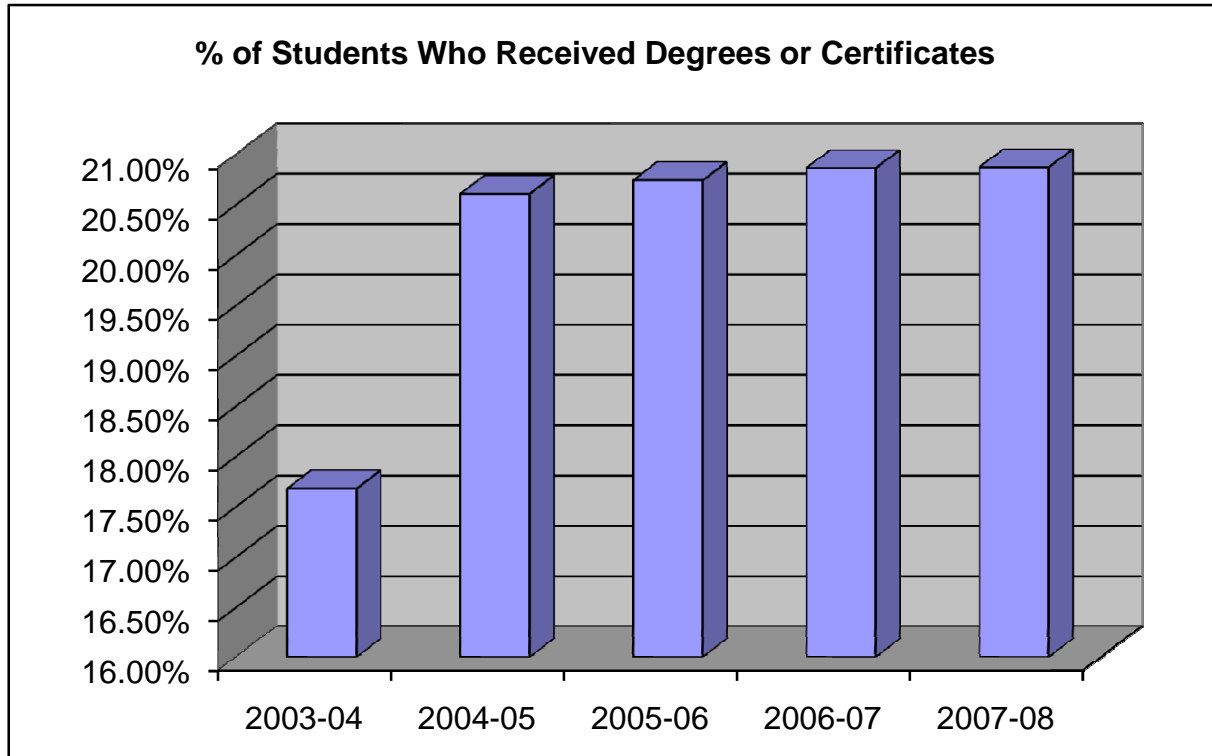

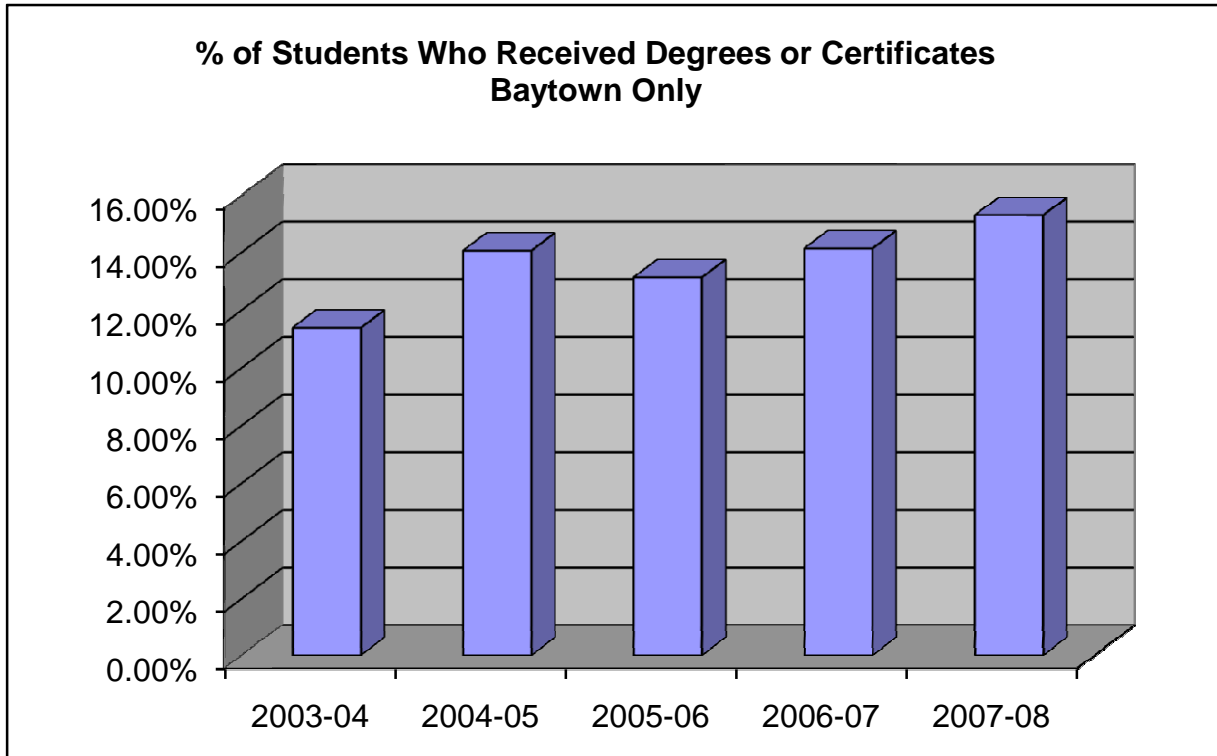

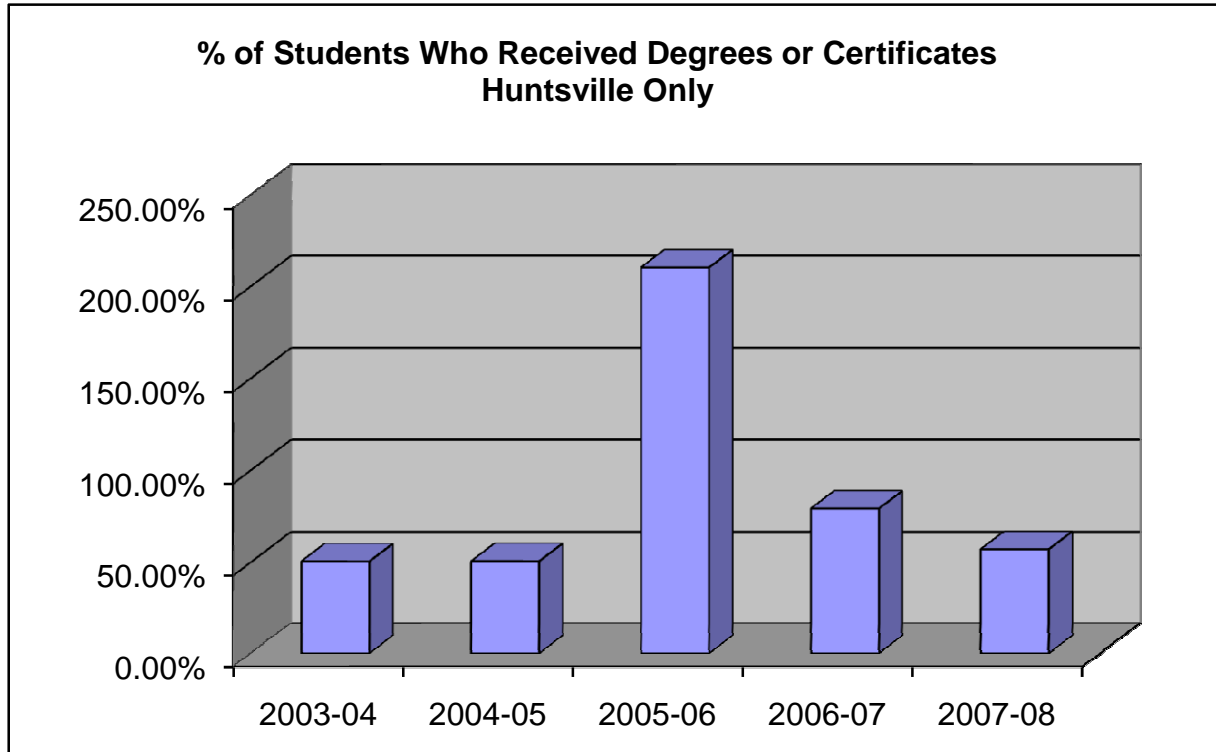

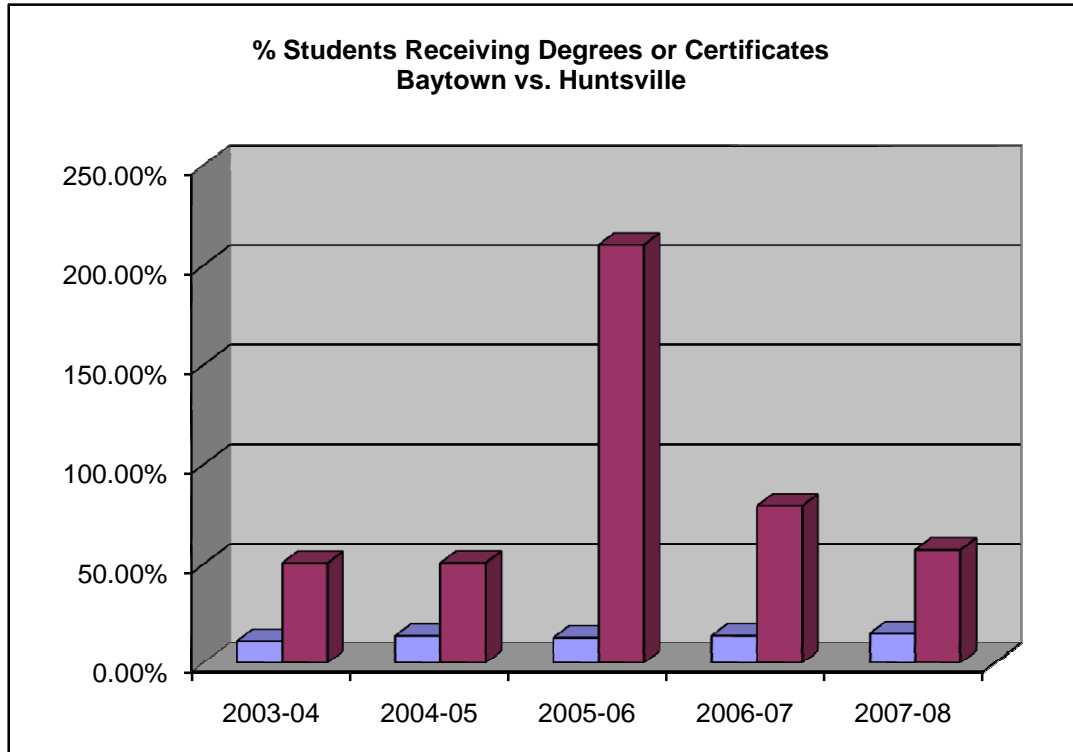

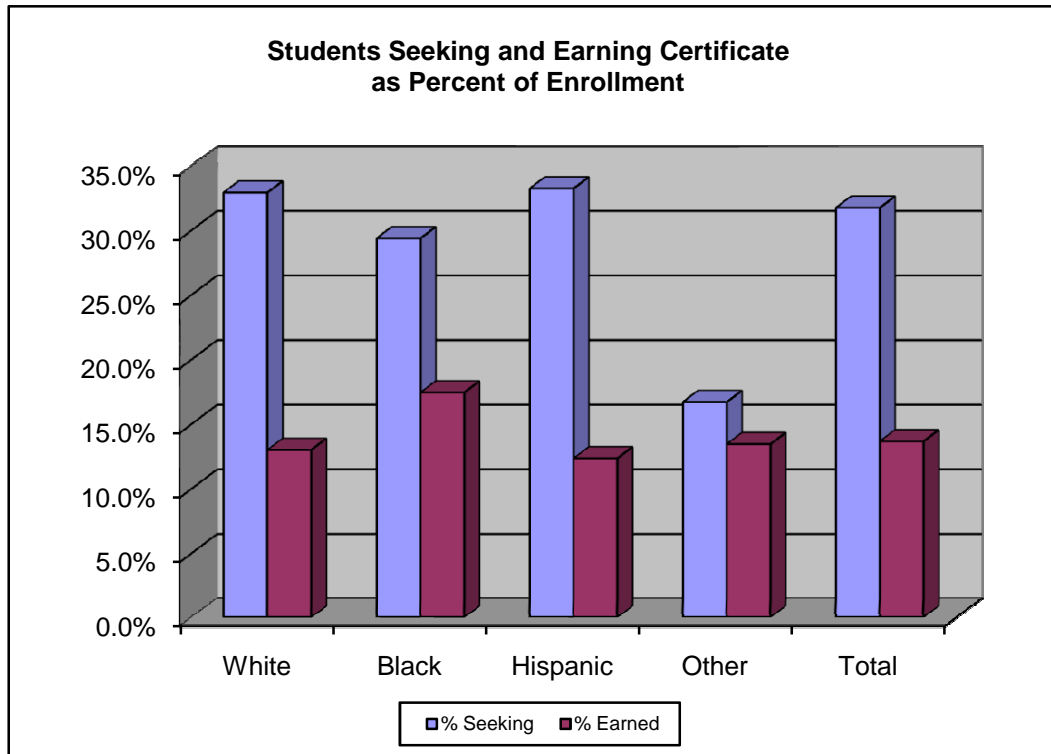

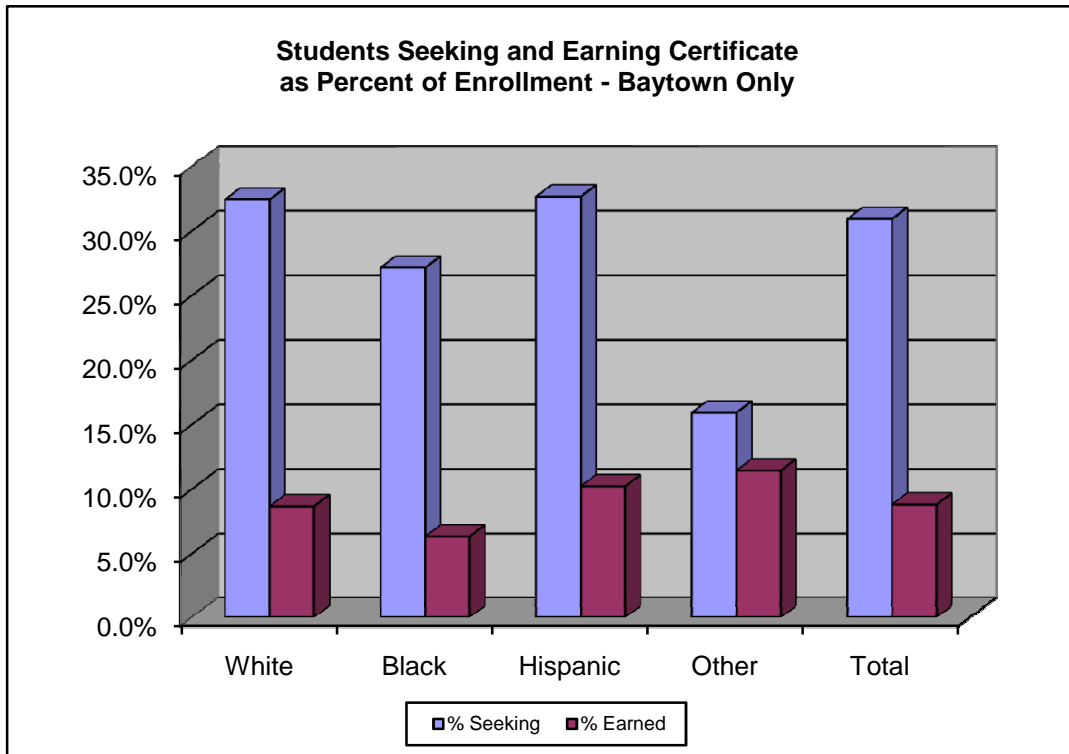

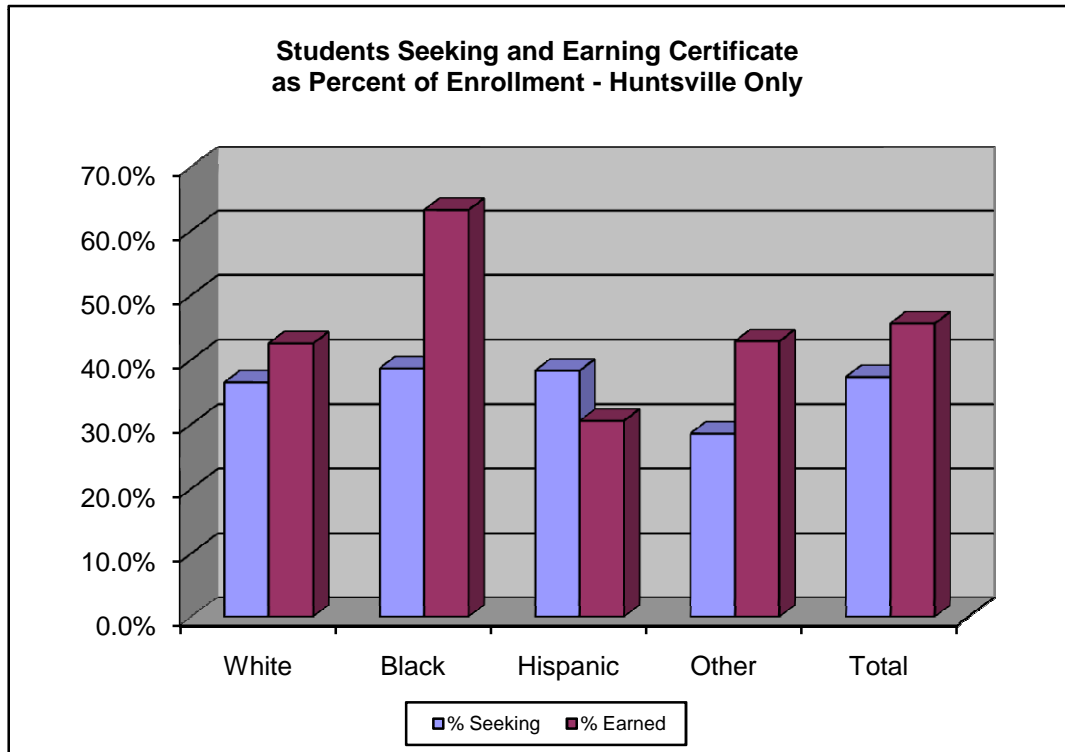

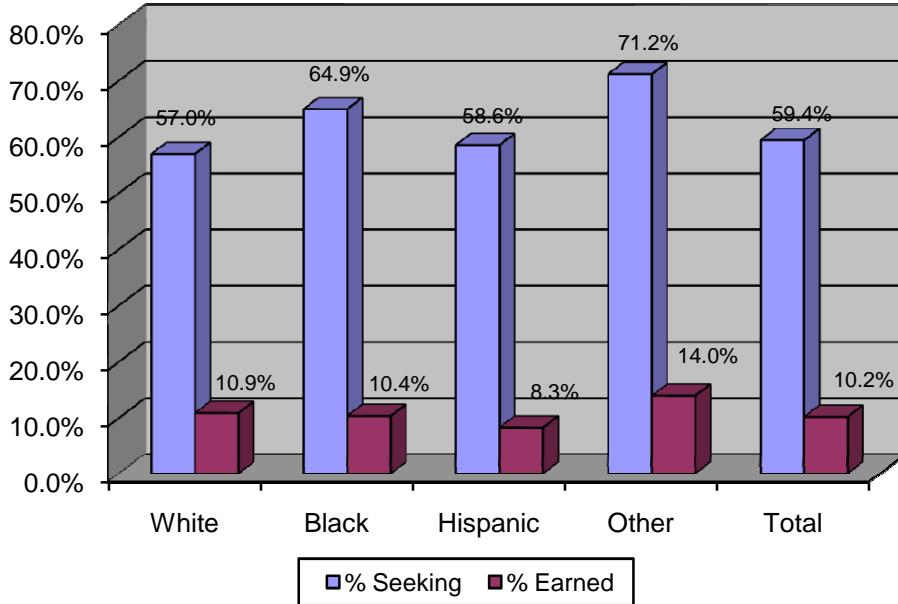

Types of Degrees Earned

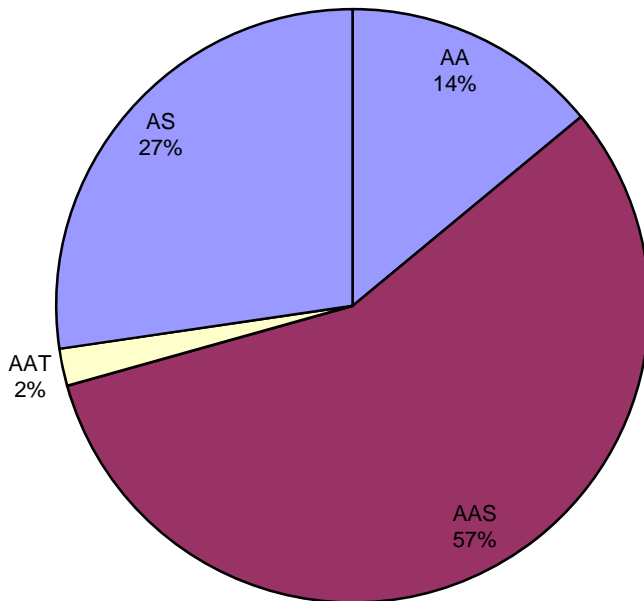

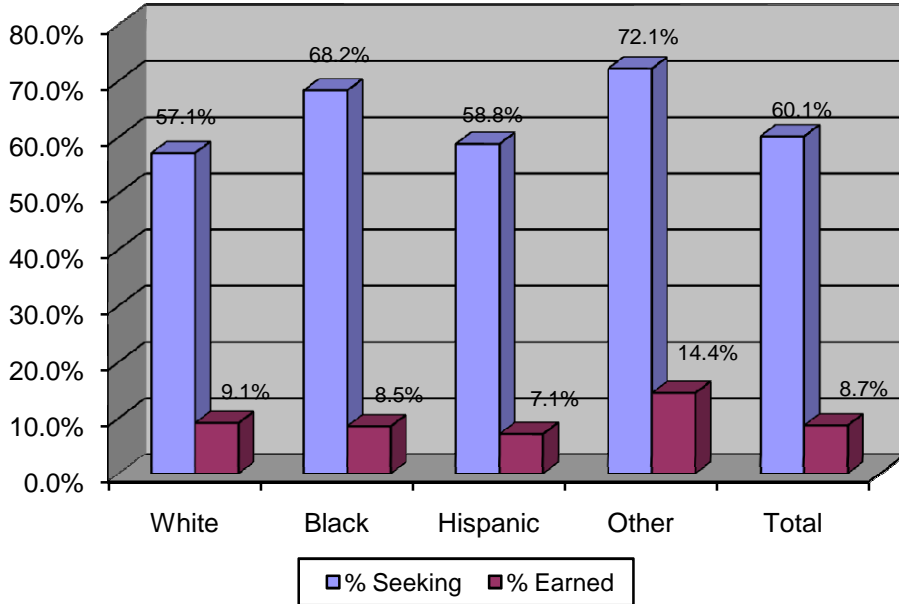

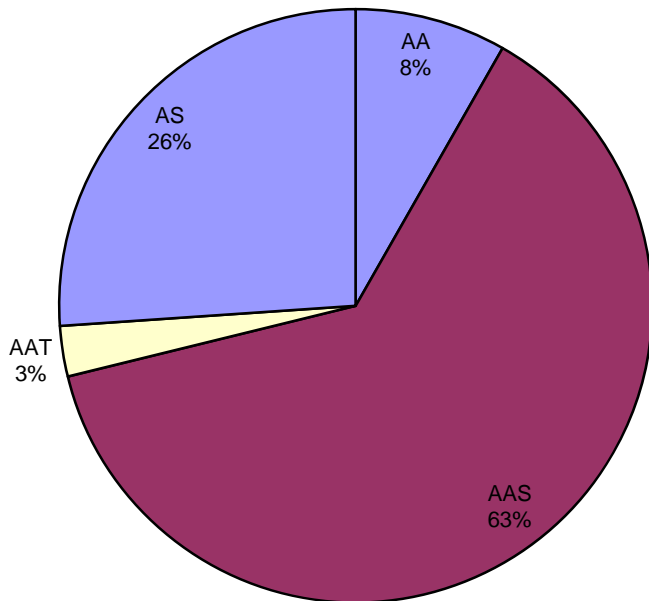

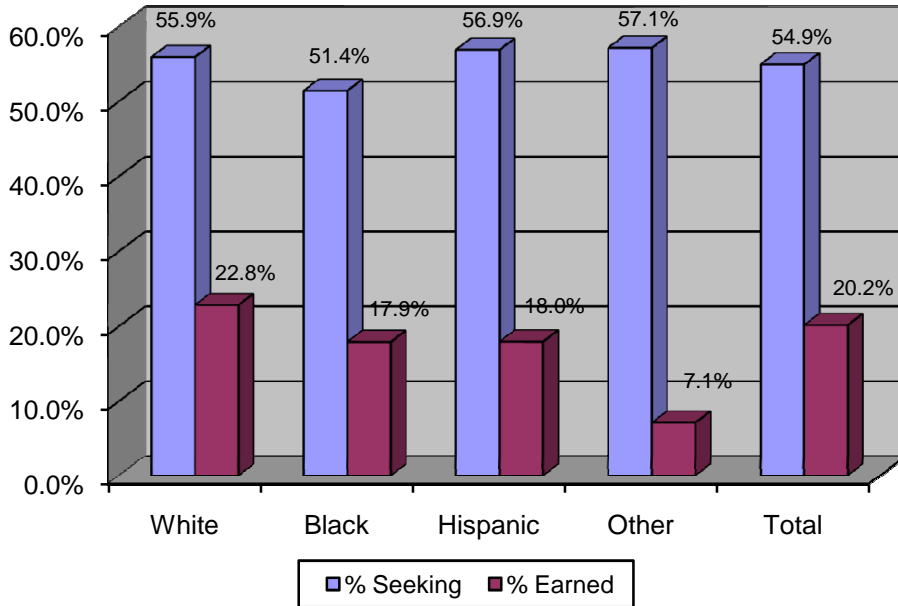

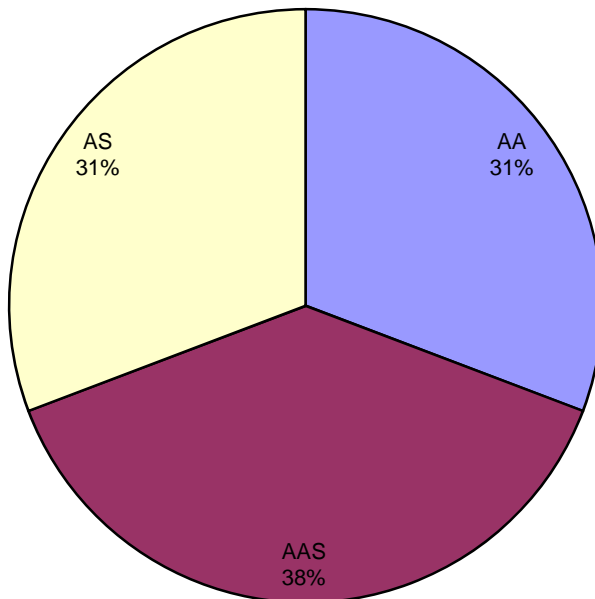
