Spring 2005 Enrollment Report

The Spring 2005 Enrollment Report contains Unduplicated Headcount, Duplicated Headcount, Student Credit Hour, and Contact Hour data. The Spring 2005 data are compared with Spring 2004 and Spring 2003.

The data in this report are summarized from the CBM001 and CBM004 data submitted to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.

Highlights of the Report

- Spring 2005 total Unduplicated Headcount was 6,304, down 1.8% from Spring 2004 (6,421), and down 12.4% from Spring 2003 (7,194).
 - Total Unduplicated Headcount for the Baytown campus was 4,992, down 1.2% from Spring 2004 (5,053), and down 14.0% from Spring 2003 (5,804).
 - Total Unduplicated Headcount for the Huntsville campus was 1,317, down 3.7% from Spring 2004 (1,368), and down 5.3% from Spring 2003 (1,390).

- Spring 2005 total Duplicated Headcount was 17,430, down 4.2% from Spring 2004 (18,190), and down 3.9% from Spring 2003 (18,139).
 - Total Duplicated Headcount for the Baytown campus was 14,641, down 1.5% from Spring 2004 (14,869), and down 0.7% from Spring 2003 (14,746).
 - Total Duplicated Headcount for the Huntsville campus was 2,789, down 16.0% from Spring 2004 (3,321), and down 17.8% from Spring 2003 (3,393).

- Spring 2005 total Student Credit Hours were 53,741, down 3.9% from Spring 2004 (55,926), and down 2.5% from Spring 2003 (55,125).
 - Total Student Credit Hours for the Baytown campus were 44,535, down 1.7% from Spring 2004 (45,284), and up 0.2% from Spring 2003 (44,455).
 - Total Student Credit Hours for the Huntsville campus were 9,206, down 13.5% from Spring 2004 (10,642), and down 13.7% from Spring 2003 (10,670).

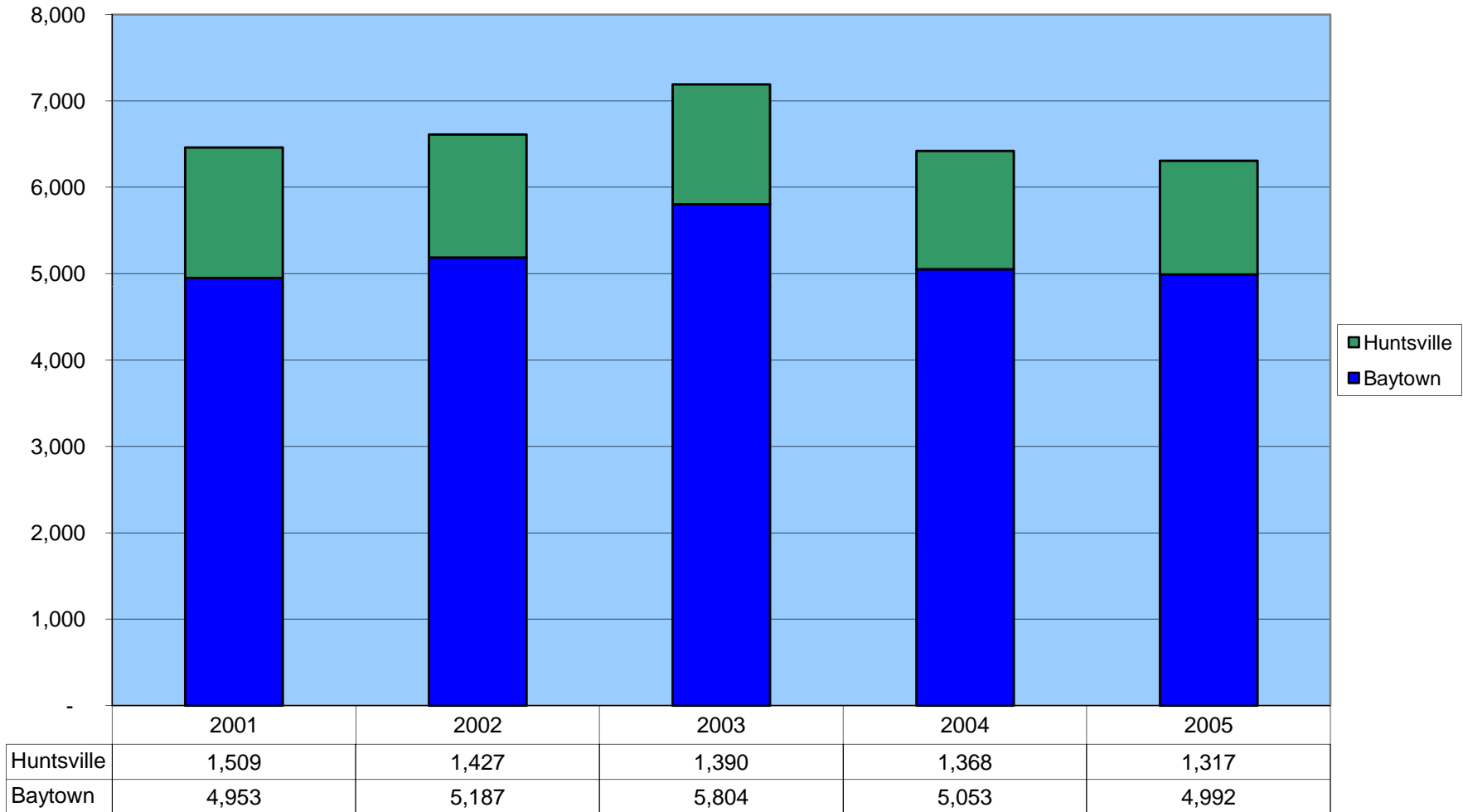
- Spring 2005 total Contact Hours were 1,155,760, down 4.1% from Spring 2004 (1,203,024), and down 2.4% from Spring 2003 (1,184,720).
 - Total Contact Hours for the Baytown campus were 919,376, down 0.7% from Spring 2004 (925,536), and down 0.4% from Spring 2003 (922,992).
 - Total Contact Hours for the Huntsville campus were 236,384, down 14.8% from Spring 2004 (277,488), and down 9.7% from Spring 2003 (261,728).

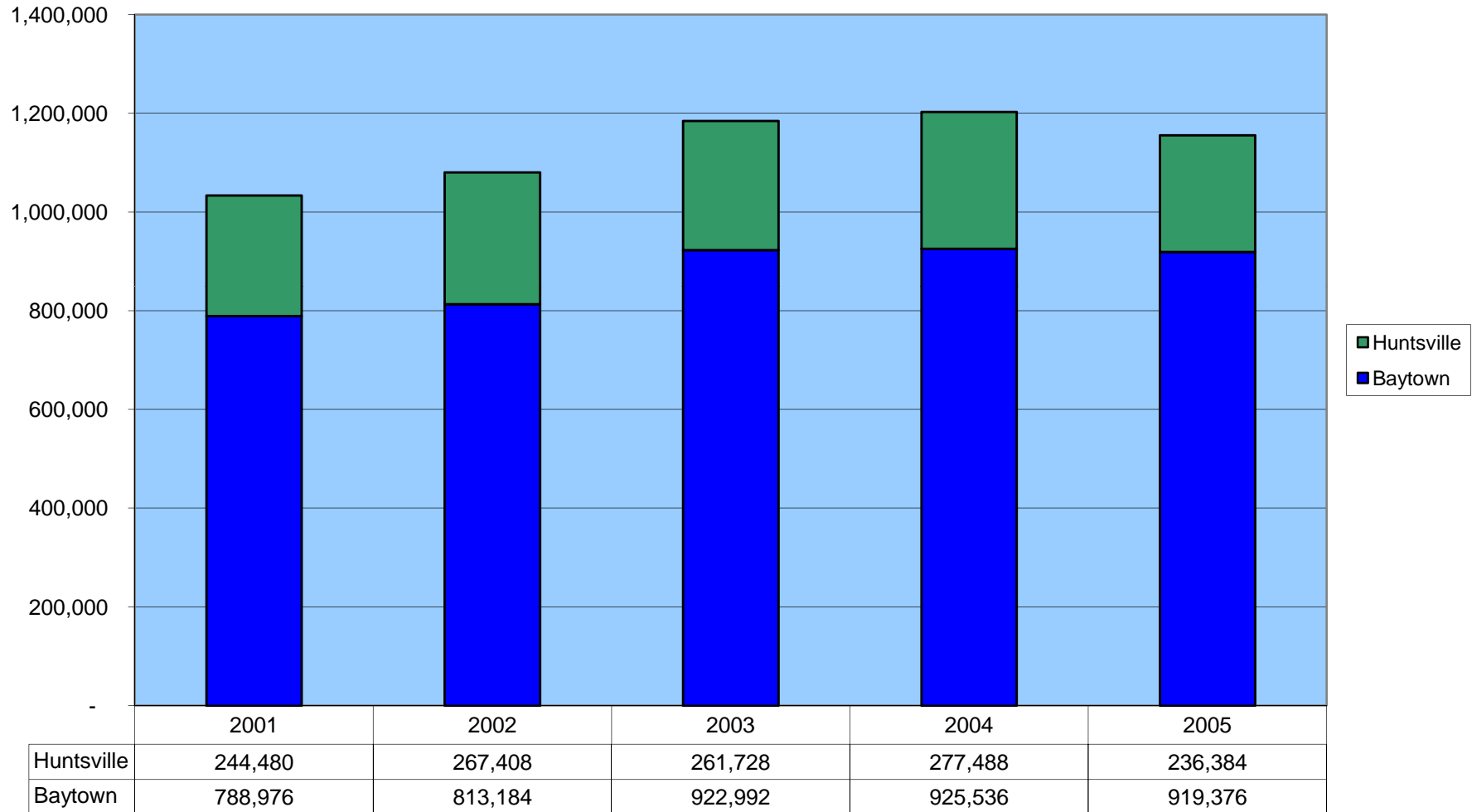
