Time Commitment

For the Child Development Program, students will attend class on Monday and Tuesday and Wednesday evening (usually from 6pm to 8:45p). Most classes are 2-4 hours long. The degree plan is made up of 5 semesters or twenty months of study. You start in January of the Spring semester. Take classes in the Summer semester, Fall semester and Spring semester again. After finishing the second Summer semester classes or in 20 months, you will graduate with your Associates degree. In addition to your Associates, students will also concurrently earn 3 Certificates of Completion for no extra cost.



Cost

The Child Development program is 60 credits in total. The approximate cost for the entire degree for an in-district student from start to finish is about \$5,000. Lee College has several avenues to assist students with tuition, books and fees. With the support of the College Completion Coach, you can apply for federal financial aid, grants and scholarships.



Career Future

The Child Development Program provides quality child development skills for personnel working with young children with an emphasis on birth to age five in community-based programs who do not desire a teacher certification. Graduates will have a strong background in the physical/cognitive/social and emotional development of young children, emergent literacy, children with disabilities, diversity, families and communities and curriculum for young children. Career opportunities are Teacher/Lead Teacher in child care center, preschool or head start program; Early Childhood Intervention Program; Child Life Specialist; Manager of Children's Program.
