Restart at Lee Application and Agreement

Lee College students who have financial holds up to \$1,500 with Lee, and who have not been enrolled at Lee for two or more semesters are eligible to re-enroll under an initiative called Restart at Lee.

The main goal of Restart at Lee is to get Lee College students who have left because of a debt owed to the college, to return so that they can graduate with a credential. Upon completion of your credential, you are eligible to have your prior debt forgiven.

By initialing the following statements and signing below, I agree to participate in the Restart at Lee Program beginning with the following term:

My declared degree or certificate plan is:

I have not been enrolled at Lee College in the last two semesters.

The total amount I owe to Lee College for past debts totals no more than \$1,500.00.

I have a completed FAFSA on file and will continue to complete the current FAFSA applications annually as required until completion of this agreement.

I understand that I must be able to pay for my current and future enrollment without incurring any additional debt to Lee College.

I understand that the debt will be forgiven when I complete my declared degree or certificate plan.

I understand I must complete with at least a 2.0 GPA to uphold this agreement and be awarded my degree or certificate.

I understand that the full debt will remain on my account until I have completed the declared degree or certificate program.

I understand that if I were to accrue new debt during any subsequent semester, I will be unable to enroll further until that new debt is cleared.

I understand that this agreement will become null and void if I fail to register for classes for 2 consecutive semesters.

I agree to meet each term with my Advisor to discuss my degree plan and progress toward completion.
