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Notes/Comments:

- (1) 36 hours of technical work-force class will transfer in-block. (in-block credits listed plus 2 hours from ACCT 2401 and 2402, will make up the 36 hours required).
- (2) ECON 2300, ECON 2301, or ECON 2302 satisfy the Core Curriculum requirement for Component Area VIII (Social and Behavioral Sciences), and degree requirement.
- (3) BANA 2372 is a prerequisite for BANA 3363. Students transferring in or choosing BANA 2372 as a course option will need three additional hours of advanced credit.
- 4) Advanced Business Electives include any course with a/an ACCT, BANA, BUAD, ECON, FINC, MGIS, MGMT, MKTG, or REAL prefix (3000- or 4000- level, not BUAD 3301) or CATM 4360.
- (5) If BANA 2372 is taken, then 3 additional hours of advanced credits are required. Minimum of thirty-six semester hours of advanced level credits (courses taken at the junior-senior [3000-4000] level at a senior institution) required.
- (6) BUAD 2301 will substitute for BUAD 3301. The course will not be counted toward advanced level credits required. An additional 3 credits of advanced level business electives will be required.

*Sam Houston State University accepts a maximum of 66 semester credit hours plus 4 hours of activity-based physical education (kinesiology) for a total of 70 semester credit hours from the accredited community colleges attended.
