The cosmetology program prepares students in all aspects of haircutting, hair design and cosmetology techniques. The program consists of training in theoretical foundations, manipulative skills, business knowledge, professional and ethical practices and prepares students to take the Texas State Board of Cosmetology examination for licensure.

Technical certificates prepare students for entry into high-demand careers. Advancement in the field may require a technical degree. Additional general education courses allow students to complete an Associate of Applied Science degree.
