- **LANDSCAPE DESIGN** — This includes training in the Earth friendly Xeriscaping (water-wise landscaping) field. This aspect of the Horticulture field integrates art and science to create a beautiful landscape with Earth friendly concepts in mind.
- **NURSERY MANAGEMENT** — Every aspect of nursery production from seed to liner is explored.
- **INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT** — The student learns various techniques in pest management with a focus on organic solutions.
- **PLANT PROPAGATION** — The student performs hands on experimentation with various forms of plant propagation.
