### **Is the LCHC Reentry Department the same as the TDCJ Reentry and Integration Division?**

No. The LCHC Reentry Department is distinct from TDCJ Reentry—they help get your Social Security card, birth certificate, and State ID. We are dedicated to helping LCHC students complete their education and find employment relative to the Lee College education they receive.

### **What does the Reentry Department do?**

The job of the Lee College Reentry Department is to provide our current and former students with a pathway to successful reintegration back into society through providing wraparound support services.

### **What are some of the wraparound support services the LCHC Reentry Department provides?**

- A 6-week Reentry Course that focuses on self-awareness, soft skills, financial literacy, digital literacy, and much more.
- Correspondence with students for requested resources and information on housing, further education, and employment availability.

# ***How to Continue Your Education with Lee College After Release***

If you are a current or former Lee College student who is unable to finish your AAS degree before release, here are the steps to finish online when released.

- 1.** Contact your Reentry Specialist at **reentry@lee.edu** or 936.755.7244.
- 2.** We will contact the appropriate Academic Advisor at our main campus in Baytown, TX about your desire to finish your degree online.
- 3.** Admissions at main campus will verify your email, phone number, and address.
- 4.** The Registrar at the main campus will then switch your inside account over to an active outside account.
- 5.** Financial Aid will review and see if you need to fill out a new FAFSA or have remaining Pell funding. You may be eligible for other grants and loans.
- 6.** The Academic Advisor on main campus will advise you of the remaining classes you need to complete your degree.
- 7.** Finally, you will be enrolled in classes.

## ***Why Contact LCHC Reentry First?***

- 1.** The Reentry Department will not only help you get to the appropriate contacts to finish your degree, but they will also provide you with social interaction that fosters community.
- 2.** The Reentry Department can help with finding resources upon release and for the students on \*Plane State Jail only, potentially provide grant money for support services and housing.
