### **COLLEGE-BOUND**

High school provides you with the opportunity to gain college credit starting in 9th grade

- Dual credit high school student enrolls in one or more college courses and receive credit for the course(s) from both the college and the high school.
- Advanced Placement (AP) classes that are taught in core subjects. These classes have a test at the end where if you pass, you can earn college credit.
