- From 2014 to 2019, jobs increased by 34.1% in Chambers County, TX from 13,280 to 17,802. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 7.3% by 26.8%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 60.7% to 58.7% between 2014 and 2019.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.0% of Chambers County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.8% below the national average), and **10.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2019 are Utility System Construction, Basic Chemical Manufacturing, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).










Chambers County, TX had an October 2019 unemployment rate of 4.10%, decreasing from 5.76% 5 years before.




Chambers County, TX has 8,807 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 8,728.

Retirement risk is low in Chambers County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 12,289 people 55 or older, while there are 9,758 here.




Racial Diversity

Chambers County, TX has 2.9 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.87 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime




Top Growing Industries



Top Industry LQ




Top Industry GRP








Top Occupation Earnings




