- The Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2.0 (TSIA2) is the assessment instrument used to determine college readiness for non-exempt students, as required by the Texas Success Initiative.
- Testing service support for our faculty by allowing students to take make-up exams or exams for online courses that need to be administered on campus.
- Testing services that meet the community's needs by offering the GED<sup>®</sup>, SAT<sup>®</sup>, ACT<sup>®</sup>, and proctored exams for other institutions.
