Program Admissions Requirements:

- Students who have completed the general education core (42 hours), earned a minimum 2.25 cumulative GPA, including a “C” in MATH 1324-Mathematics for Business and Social Sciences and satisfied TSI obligation may be admitted to the Davies College of Business.
- UHD will calculate the higher grade received on duplicate courses for GPA requirements.
- UHD will accept a “D” in courses except for MATH 1324, STAT 2305, ACC 2301, and ACC 2302. courses.

Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits:

- Credits from LEE that are transferrable to UHD degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
- Reverse transfer
- LEE students will be allowed access to academic advising services at UHD
- LEE Honors students admitted to UHD will receive:
 - o Acceptance to UHD Honors Program with a minimum GPA (GPA varies by the College in which the program resides)
 - o UHD will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credit; eligible for merit and need-based aid commensurate with qualifications
